



CH +/-: Press to scan through channels.


INPUT: Press to display the input source menu.



- ②After the flying squirrel and a TV remote control have been infrared transmitter aligned, press the POWER button of the TV control, then LED of the air mouse will light, indicating that the air mouse has receive the code value that from TV remote control.
- ③Click the key of the air mouse that need to learn, the LED light becomes slow flashing, which means that the TV remote cotrol air mouse has received the code values.

④After the success of learning, you can press TV button to exit the learning mode, and then LED stop to light.

# 4. System Connections

Do not connect the power cord until all other connections have been made.

## 4.1 Connecting to Power Supply

- 1. Connect the power cord correctly as shown.
- 2. Press the POWER switch of your LCD TV to switch on the LCD TV. The power indicator on the front panel lights up in Green.




## 4.2 Connection to External AV Signal Source

Use the audio and video cable to connect the input jacks on the rear panel of the unit to the external AV signal source.

Connect the unit and the external AV signal source to the respective jacks with the S-Video cable.

Ensure that you observe the color cord when connecting audio and video cables.




After connection, turn on the power of the unit and the external AV signal source. Press **SOURCE** then direction buttons to select AV mode, and then press the **ENTER** button to confirm.

The L/R audio input jacks can be used in the both Composite modes.

## 4.3 Connecting to External AV Signal Source (HDMI)

Follow the figure below to connect an HDMI signal source to the HDMI jack on the rear panel of the unit.




After connection, turn on the power of the unit and the external AV signal source and use the SOURCE and the direction buttons to select HDMI mode, and then press the ENTER button to confirm.

i HDMI provides both audio and video signals and typically provides superior image quality to component or composite.

## 4.4 Connecting to T2/S2

Connect the TV T2/S2 cable (the antenna cable, for example) to the antenna input jack on the back of the unit so that you can receive television programmers.



After connection, turn on the power of unit. Then press the SOURCE button to select ATV or DTV mode and conduct program selection.











# 7. Troubleshooting

Carry out the problem-solving measures described in the following section before contacting customer support. Turn off the device immediately as soon as you suspect a malfunction and unplug the power plug. Do not attempt to repair the device yourself.

LCD screen stays	Make sure the unit is turned on and the connections are correct.
Dark.	Make sure the power adapter is correctly connected.
There is no sound	Make sure the system connection is correct.
	Make sure the power of speaker is turned on.
There is no picture or	Make if the connections with the external AV signal source are correct.
picture move up and down unsteady.	Correctly set the items in the picture menu.
	Check if the video type input signal is not corresponding to the unit.
	Make sure the unit is turned on and in correct video type.
	Make sure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the unit.
The remote control does	Make sure the remote control is pointing at the unit.
not work.	Make sure the batteries are inserted or the polarity is correct.
	Make sure the batteries are not weak. Replace the weak battery.

## Other Notes:

Static or other external interfere may cause the player to behave abnormally. If this occurs, unplug the power-supply cord from the outlet and plug it in again to reset the player. If the problems persist, then please disconnect the power and consult a qualified technician
