



Important Information

- Keep fittings out of children's reach and keep children well away from construction area.






- i) SELECT BT; PLEASE RAISE VOLUME ON DEVICE TO HIGH LEVEL THEN ADJUST RC.
- ii) SELECT OPTICAL; PLEASE MUTE TV SPEAKERS FOR BEST RESULTS.

ONE MAY OCCASIONALLY NEED TO ADJUST TV SETTINGS FOR EXTERNAL SPEAKERS, THIS DEPENDS ON THE MAKE OF TV, PLEASE CHECK THE TV USER GUIDE. RESULTS.




ADJUST BASS - THIS BUTTON LIMITS LOWER FREQUENCIES OF THE SOUND

ADJUST BASS ATTENTUATION TO SUIT THE SOUND EFFECT YOU LIKE




ADJUST TREBLE - THIS BUTTON LIMITS HIGH FREQUENCIES OF THE SOUND

ADJUST TREBLE ATTENTUATION TO SUIT THE SOUND EFFECT YOU LIKE. NOTE IF YOU REDUCE LEVEL OF THE HIGHER FREQUENCIES, SOUND VOLUME IS REDUCED - THIS IS NORMAL.



SELECT BT (BLUETOOTH) - DEVICE INPUT - TO PAIR LOOK FOR "BT SPEAKER"


NOTE THAT IF TV IS IN THE UP POSITION AND SWITCHED ON, TV PICTURE IS STILL SHOWING, IT IS NOT SWITCHED OFF WHEN BLUETOOTH IS SELECTED. TO REMOVE, TURN OFF TV OR PRESS THE RC DOWN BUTTON TO LOWER TV TO REST POSITION WHERE TV POWER IS DISCONNECTED AUTOMATICALLY - MUSIC CAN STILL PLAY.







PRESS ON/OFF FOR THREE SECONDS TO SWITCH WHOLE SYSTEM OFF.
























Step 23 If you purchased Double or King size, unfold slat frame and then follow Step 25 onwards. Step 24 If you purchased Super King size, first un-fold metal slat frame (13), fit the cross bar (14) then follow step 25 onwards. CAREFULLY FIT CROSS BAR (14) FOR ADDITIONAL STRENGTH







NOTE: Before moving the slat frame, mattress must be placed on the slats as the speed of upward movement is very high and may cause injury. Lift frame with the hand-strap then slowly push down ensuring the edges are aligned with the side panels. If not aligned, check bed is still square (see Step 4). Depending on the weight of the mattress, the speed of the lift will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed. Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.


NOTE: With mattress in place, move the frame up & down five times to lubricate the pistons.

Occasionally you may find the radio wave connection between remote control and TV Lift is lost, probably due to atmospheric conditions. In that case please follow these simple instructions:



- (1). Disconnect all mains electric power to the bed, for at least 60 seconds.
- (2). Press UP or DOWN Button on Remote Control and keep holding button down, simultaneously re-connect mains electric power to bed keeping button down for at least a further 5 seconds. TV Lift unit receives signal from Remote Control and lift will begin to move UP or DOWN whichever direction is appropriate.
- ③. Re-connection is now completed.

Care Instructions

- Avoid exposing the furniture to excessive heat or direct sunlight as this can cause cracking and deterioration of the colour.
- Periodically check & re-tighten any fastener.
- Periodically dust lightly with a light vacuum cleaner or wipe with a clean soft cloth.
- Do not use silicone based furniture polish.
- Any spills should be removed immediately with a soft damp cloth.
- TAKE CARE WHEN MOVING THE FURNITURE AND NEVER DRAG THE PIECES ACROSS THE FLOOR, AS THIS WILL CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE JOINTS.

TV BED SAFETY INFORMATION



GENERAL INFORMATION

It is very important not to place any vessel containing liquids, e.g. drinks or vase of flowers, on top of the TV footboard which may accidentally spill and enter the TV compartment as this could cause damage to the TV and/or the TV lifting equipment.

If this happens, please contact your retailer.

Do not expose the bed to an undue level of heat - keep away from radiators.

Never allow anyone to sit on the foot end of the bed - keep children well away from moving parts.

To keep bed clean, we recommend that it be wiped over with a slightly dampened cloth or if fabric, use a light vacuum cleaner; disconnect power before cleaning.

Supplied with the bed is a remote control to operate the TV Lift and when you fit your own TV there is a remote control to operate it as well. Both these remotes use batteries - there are no batteries in the rest of the equipment.

There are strict controls for disposal of batteries - your local council can advise on how to safely dispose of them.

Never burn batteries on an open fire as they could explode.

IMPORTANT POWER INFORMATION

It is essential that the Mains Power Lead (S) is connected to an $\underline{\text{earthed}}$ socket be it a wall socket or extension lead otherwise there is risk of damage or even electric-shock.

The socket providing the power must be accessible at all times in case you need to switch off the power quickly.

During an electrical or lightening storm - disconnect the power completely as a precaution.

Always un-plug the power when going on holiday or when the bed is not used for an extended period.

If you have young children in the home always disconnect the power at the wall socket for extra safety.

Power outlets, extension leads or adapters must not be overloaded beyond their limit - this can result in fire or electric shock. Leads supplied with this bed, or other approved mains powered extension leads used to power the equipment, must not be placed where they can be walked on - this is dangerous and could lead to accidents.

Do not interfere with or modify any cables already fitted and do not add any extra media leads unless they are routed through the ducts as shown in Stage 10. All leads must be tightly connected to back of TV, never hanging loose.

Never touch moving parts or any part of the equipment - if something needs to be checked, disconnect the power first. Do not insert anything into the footboard as this could seriously damage the TV and/or the TV lifting equipment and could, if done carelessly, cause serious damage or injury.

If the equipment doesn't operate normally or if there is any unusual noises, disconnect the power.

IMPORTANT: Care should be taken when connecting electrical items. If you are in any doubt about the connections please consult an approved electrician. If you still have a problem please contact your retailer for advice.

TELEVISION INSTALLATION

Before fixing the slats frame to the bed, please follow the television installation instructions below Raise the TV Lift by pressing the TOP button of the remote control.

Connect the TV using the TV Installation Kit packed in the accessory box in carton 2. If screws are supplied with your TV, use these in preference.

Connect the TV to the mounting bracket plate as in Step 11 or 12.

If necessary mounting plate can easily be adjusted to move TV up or down.

Connect the TV Power Lead (supplied with TV) by passing plug down one of the ducts, plugging it into the adapter if required then into the TV power socket which is on the face of footboard - see Step 8.

Note that this socket is only to be used for the TV, power output is not constant.

Arrange the Aerial & HDMI cable (T&U) by passing down the appropriate duct - see Step 10.

If required, connect your own media cables through either of the ducts then connect your media equipment.

Please use the cable clips & cable ties to make certain there are no loose wires to snag.

The TV can now be operated following the TV Operation Guide supplied with your TV.

When finished viewing lower the TV back into the footboard by pressing DOWN button of the remote control.

The TV will retract into the footboard automatically - power shall be turned off when TV reaches the bottom.

When the UP button is pressed - the TV Lifting Column rises and power to the TV turns back on automatically.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If your equipment does not operate please check all the power connections to the wall and to the socket in the footboard. Make sure TV is switched on. (Note: TV will only work when it is in the up position).

Follow instruction at the top of Page 22 to make certain pairing of Remote Control has not been lost.

If the television or TV Lift still fails to operate contact your retailer.

IMPORTANT. Care should be taken when connecting electrical items. If in any doubt please consult an approved electrician to advise you on the electrical supply to achieve safe connections, to the electrical equipment of the TV Bed.
