

USA & CANADA

Ensure that the rated luminaire voltage requirements are compatible with the available mains supply in which it will be installed. All LEDS are included in your lamp. Never touch the LED surface with your bear hands as

this may reduce the life of your LED. Do not alter, relocate or remove any electrical component.

Material: Natural Wood Venner, MDF and carbon steel.

Read carefully all the Assembly Instructions below, before starting the installation process.

Turn OFF the power before starting the installation.

- (1) Use the support base as template to drill on the ceiling the holes needed for support. Use an 8mm drill, and insert the provided bushings on the holes.
- Pass the support cables through the cable anchors at the canopy, adjusting the desired height for the pendant to be suspended. To adjust the height, press the tip of the cable anchor while sliding the cable in. Release the cable anchor tip, and the suspension cable will be locked.
- (3) Reserve the cable excess by wrapping it inside the canopy, ensuring that it does not touch any electrical connections, or simply cut the excess off.
- (4) Pass the power cable through the strain relief (S) on the canopy and junction box cover (JB) and the mounting crossbar (C), at the desired suspension height. Connect the electrical supply wires to the mains supply at the junction box in accordance with all the applicable codes. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product, and the hazards involved.
- (5) Attach the mounting crossbar and junction box cover to the junction box using the supplied screws (S2).
- (6) Use the screw on the center of the support base (S3), to fix it to the previously installed crossbar. Also, use the (S1) screws to fixate the support base on the previously installed bushings.
- O Bring the canopy close to the support base, and tighten the finishing screws (S4) on the sides of the canopy, to lock the canopy to the support base. Then, tighten the plastic screw on the strain relief to anchor the power cable.
- 8 Install GU10-MR11 LED bulbs on the sockets, with maximum wattage of 5W each.

USER GUIDE

TIP: To install the bulbs, stick a piece of tape on the side of the bulb, as shown. Fit the bulb into the socket, and then, carefully pull the tape clockwise, to twist and lock the bulb into the socket. After the click, hold the bulb and carefully remove the tape from the bulb.

If you do not wish to install all the bulbs on the luminaire, use the provided covers to close the tubes that not contain a lamp.

Turn ON the electrical power.

Your luminaire is now ready for use.
