To Install the Canopy (Figure 1)

Component Parts

A Ground Screw E Canopy
B Crossbar F Canopy Loop
C Lock Nut G Loop Collar
D Nipple H Fixture Loop

Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation


- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.
- 2. Using two machine screws (not provided), fasten the crossbar (B) to the electric box (see illustration).

Note: A new electric box comes with screws. When replacing a fixture, retain the existing screws for use with the new fixture.

- 3. Thread the nipple (D) into the crossbar (B) and secure with lock nut (C); slide canopy (E) over nipple (D), and attach the canopy loop (F) to the nipple (D). Adjust the nipple to proper length to ensure a snug canopy fit before proceeding.
- 4. Attach one end of the chain to the fixture loop (H). Lace the wire through every other link of the chain to the end. Slip wires and chain through the collars and canopy (G, F & E). Fasten the chain to the canopy loop (F), then slip wires through the loop and nipple, into the electric box. Make sure to provide enough slack in the wire to ensure weight of fixture is supported by the chain.
- 5. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided) connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to ribbed side of the fixture s cord, black to smooth side). Run a pigtail lead from crossbar ground screw (A) to the junction box and connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green).

Caution: Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely, and no bare wire is exposed.

6. Raise canopy (E) to the ceiling and secure loop collar (G) to canopy loop (F).





To Install Opaque Glass (Figure 2)

Component Parts

- I Retaining Ring (5)
- J Glass (5)
- K Socket (5)
- L Socket Tool
- 1. Remove retaining ring (I) from socket (K). *Retaining Rings are shipped installed.*
- 2. Place glass (J) over socket (K).
- 3. Replace retaining ring (I) and tighten with socket tool (L) to secure glass. *Do not over-tighten*.
- 4. Install light bulbs.
- 5. Restore electricity at the main breaker.



To Install Water Glass (Figures 3 & 4)

Component Parts


- I Retaining Ring (5)
- J Glass (5)
- K Socket (5)
- M Decorative Ring Cover (5)
- 1. Remove retaining ring (I) from socket (K). *Retaining Rings are shipped installed.*
- 2. Install retaining ring (I) into decorative ring cover (M). If retaining ring (I) fits to loose bend a few inside tabs of the decorative ring cover (M) (Figure 4).
- 3. Place glass (J) over socket (K).
- 4. Replace retaining ring (I) and tighten to secure glass. *Do not over-tighten*.
- 5. Install light bulb.
- 6. Restore electricity at the main breaker.
