



Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Remove faceplate from canopy by unscrewing cable mounts shown below. Mount canopy to ceiling following included mounting instructions. Make wire connections from drivers to source power .



Step 2: with canopy mounted and faceplate off: hang pendants through hole shown below by feeding cable through hole and tying into a loose knot to hold in place, this will allow you to determine desired pendant heights before you cut the cables. Once desired heights is determined, mark the cable where it enters the hole, this is the cut location.




Step 3: Cut conductive cables to desired length using **cable cutters, not wire cutters or diagonal cutters**. Failure to use cable cutters will result in the inner conductive cable not being cut cleanly.


Step 4: Re-install faceplate and cable mounts

Step 5: Connect conductive cable to the canopy.


- A. Mark the conductive cable 1-1/8" from both ends.
- B. Unscrew the Cap from the cord gripper and slide it over the conductive cable.
- C. Cut the outer sheathing and insulator with a **16 Ga. Wire stripper**. Open the stripper, rotate 90° and repeat until sheathing is completely cut.
- D. Strip the wire by wrapping the cable around your hand and use a 14 Ga. Wire Stripper.
- E. Flare out the outer braided sheathing so that it will lay on the outside of the nipple on the cable gripper
- F. Insert cable into gripper until it bottoms out. The insulator will go into the gripper while the outer sheathing will lay over the outside.
- G. Secure the cap back onto the gripper. Be careful when tightening the cap not to cut the outer sheathing.
- H. Smooth out sheathing by pinching the cable and pulling away from the gripper.

NOTE: Cable can be released from gripper by unscrewing the threaded section under the cap and pressing the plunger while pulling on the cable.






Step 6: Install each glass element (B) one by one by threading glass piece onto the corresponding threaded mounts shown below.



**NOTE IN ORDER TO KEEP PENDANT BALANCED, OPPOSING PIECES OF GLASS NEED TO BE THE SAME SIZE, THE FIGURE BELOW SHOWS AN EXAMPLE OF THE SINGLE PENDANT WITH TWO LARGE GLASS PIECES AND TWO MEDIUM GLASS PIECES


