1A. Shall be reflective and meet minimum retroreflectivity requirements. Type II copy on Type I background is the absolute minimum, but may be cost prohibitive to manufacture.

3A. Design - Legend

3A. The design of uppercase letters, lower-case letters, numerals, route shields, and spacing shall be as provided in the "Standard Highway Signs and Markings" book.

3B. Design - U/L Case

3B. The lettering for names of places, streets, and highways on conventional road guide signs shall be a combination of lower--case letters with initial upper-case letters. All other word legends shall be in upper-case letters.

3C. Design - Letter Height

SHALL = MANDATORY

3C. The principal legend on guide signs shall be in letters and numerals at least 6 inches in height for upper-- case and upper/lower--case letters. On low--volume roads with speeds of 25 mph or less, the principal legend shall be in letters at least 4 inches in height for all upper--case and upper/lower--case letters.
