ATM BY-PASS

Does your pilot shut off when the control knob is released? You may have a faulty safety switch.

The following are instructions to test the safety switch using the by-pass method.

Step 1 Start by... Removing the <u>rear panel</u> from your unit. -or-If you have a Triangle unit, remove the panel that is closest to the pilot.

^{**}This test is for diagnostic purposes only, the unit will not shut off if it falls over. Never run your unit with the anti-tilt switch disengaged.**


Next,


Locate the safety switch. This is also know as the <u>ATM switch</u>.

Once you have located it, remove the two screws that hold it in place.



Remove the <u>two lead wires</u> from the <u>ATM switch</u>





Connect the two <u>female</u>
<u>spade connectors</u> together as shown in the image below



Once this is all finished, test the unit. If your <u>Pilot</u> stays on you will need a new <u>ATM switch</u>. Below is a link where you may purchase one.
