

Beeswax BLUE Balls®

Can assist with management of: Seedy toe, white line disease and distortion along with hoof wall separation.



PREPARE THE HOOF

- Clean the hoof and remove any debris lodged in target areas
- Flush the cracks with Hoof Spray.
- Consider using our Curved tip syringes to ensure you are getting into the cracks.

APPLICATION AREA

 Ensure application area is clean and DRY prior to applying the balls. Beeswax and the natural oils repel moisture so the balls will not adhere thoroughly if the area is still moist.

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HOW MUCH TO USE

- Our ball size is approx 12mm. If this amount it too much for smaller areas, simply break off a small portion and pack into the area.
- For large resections, you may pack in as many balls as necessary.

APPLICATION

- Ensure the area is dry and free from debris.
- Select the desired amount and firmly push into top of the the targeted area.
- Do not overpack and try to avoid ground leverage by using on the top of the hole or resection only.

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HOW OFTEN DO I APPLY?

- Longevity of the application will depend on a few factors. Environment, application process and location of packed area.
- We recommend checking daily and reapplying as necessary.

WILL THE COLD AFFECT MY BALLS?

- Yes. With Beeswax as the base ingredient, this will be much firmer in the colder months.
- You can warm the balls in your hand or pocket before application to reinstate pliability.



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HOW LONG SHOULD I CONTINUE?

 Continue the process, ensuring hoof is clean and free of debris before reapplying. Continue the process until your hoof care professional advises that the area is not in need of topical protection.
