



HOOF PACK

Can assist with Thrush relief and protection and management of Thrush in the hoof.

Daily for current infection, weekly for maintenance and prevention.

PREPARE THE HOOF

- Clean the hoof and remove any debris lodged in target areas
- Ensure hoof is clean prior to application.
- You can use our Hoof Spray prior to application. Wait a minute for the hoof to dry off slightly prior to applying.

APPLICATION AREA

 Hoof Pack - Hoof Clay for Thrush can be safely applied all over the sole of the hoof. Pay particular attention to the collateral grooves and central sulcus and ensure these areas are covered.





HOW MUCH TO USE

- Don't overpack the hoof.
- Overpacking the collateral grooves may enable the product to be removed easily by ground forces.
- A generous layer is enough at the base of the collateral grooves and central sulcus.

APPLICATION

 If using Hoof Spay or Hoof Mate prior to application, wait a minute or so for the hoof to absorb and repel the moisture.



 Hoof Pack is safe to apply daily and on sensitive areas of the hoof.



HOW OFTEN DO I APPLY?

- For best results check and reapply daily.
- For current thrush concerns, use daily.
- For prevention and maintenance, use weekly.

WILL IT COME OUT?

 Longevity of application depends on the footing environment the horse is in. It can be used for paddocked, stabled or yarded horses.
