





HOOF SPRAY

Can assist with the management of seedy toe, white line disease, hoof wall separation and thrush in hooves when used in conjunction with other products from our range.

Ideal for cleaning grooves and crevices in the hoof.

May assist with the elimination of odours associated with thrush.

May assist with softening of skin on fetlocks when required.



PREPARE THE HOOF

• Clean the hoof thoroughly with a hoof pick and brush, ensuring all debris is removed from the grooves and central sulcus.

HOW AND WHERE TO APPLY

- Shake the hoof spray bottle and spray the hoof spray into the grooves and sulcus and any other crevices and cracks.
- If using prior to application of and in conjunction with other products from our range. Ensure the Hoof Spray has thoroughly dried off prior to application of further products.

CAN I USE IN A SYRINGE?

 Absolutely. This is ideal if you have a contracted central sulcus which is hard to reach topically.
 Consider adding a 5 pack of our Curved Tip Syringes to your tack box.

HOW OFTEN DO DO I APPLY

 Hoof Spray should be used every time the hoof requires thorough cleaning. Some of our customers use daily, some use weekly. Every situation differs. 4
