## ZINC PUTTY

May assist with the management of retexturing skin on fetlocks, body and the drying effects of sun and wind. An effective UV filter.

Commonly used on fetlocks for Greasy Heel.

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### PREPARE THE AREA

- Zinc Putty should always been applied to a clean and dry area.

### HOW AND WHERE TO APPLY

- Zinc Putty is a thick zinc cream for use on all areas requiring protection (naturally avoid the eyes). It can be applied to your horses' face and muzzle and is most popular when used on fetlocks.
- Take up a small amount of Zinc Putty with clean hands. Keep in mind that a little amount goes a long way.
- Gently apply the Zinc Putty to the area requiring protection. Remain mindful that some skin conditions can be sensitive to your horse. Pressure applied to the affected areas when applying may cause your horse to negatively react.
- Ensure the targeted area requiring protection is generously covered.
- If you need more than initially applied, ensure that you avoid "double dipping" and that clean hands are used.

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### HOW OFTEN DO I APPLY

- Zinc Putty can be applied as often as needed.
- Whilst it should last for more than 24 hours – rain, dust or the horse rubbing the covered area may create a need for daily application.

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### HOW DO I KNOW WHEN TO DISCONTINUE USE

- Discontinue the use of Zinc Putty once the targeted area skin has been retextured and smoothed. You can continue to use for protection.
- Any areas of missing hair should be starting to grow back when discontinuing use.
- When being used for UV protection from the wind and sun, use your judgement for climatic conditions in your region.

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
