



## TUB AND TILE (COLORED) REPAIR KIT INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### SAFETY WARNING! ⚠️

Keep this product in a safe place, out of reach of children. Do not consume it or allow it to come into contact with your eyes. Follow the instructions provided to ensure proper application. This product may cause irritation to sensitive skin. Wear plastic gloves during use and to wash hands thoroughly with soap and water afterward.

### 📖 STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to apply the Tub and Tile repair kit to the damaged areas:

1. Clean the damaged area and remove any dirt or loose tile debris.
2. Using the wooden tool, mix an equal amount (1:1 ratio) of PART A and PART B in the mixing bowl or on a sturdy piece of clean scrap cardboard. **Make sure Parts A & B are mixed thoroughly.**
3. Apply a sufficient amount of the mixture to the damaged area and ensure that all gaps or holes are filled. Use the toothpick for small application. Smoothen using the wooden tool. If you need to add color to your mixture, refer to the Color Mixing guide on the second page of this instruction manual.
4. Wait 24 hours for the mixture to dry. If needed, use sandpaper to even out the surface of the repaired area. Be careful not to scratch those parts that are not under repair.

### ❓ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### How long does it take to dry or cure?

The curing time will sometimes vary depending on the room's temperature and humidity. The colder it is, the longer it will take for the mixture to harden. But on average, it will take at least 24 hours before the work area is ready for smoothing.

#### Why does the drying process take too long?

The mixture dries depending on the temperature in the area. A colder temperature takes longer time to dry but on an average the mixture takes 24 hours to dry

#### What can I do to ensure that the mixture works?

Ensure that equal parts of the compounds are thoroughly mixed together so that the effectiveness of the mixture is at maximum strength. Also make sure that the damaged area is free from dirt or debris to ensure proper bonding

#### If I made a mistake and put too much, how do I remove it?

Simply wipe it off before it dries.

#### Will this work for plastic bathtubs?

It only works on porcelain, fiberglass, ceramic, and acrylic.

#### Is the product safe and non-toxic?

Certainly! The formula is non-hazardous.

## COLOR MIXING GUIDE

FORTIVO's Tub and Tile Kit includes the most common colors for any repair projects. However, if you want to create a custom combination, you can do so by following the color mixing guide below.

1. Refer to the figure to determine the appropriate color for your damaged tub and tile surface.
2. Within the circle, you will find the primary colors such as white, black, tan, red, and cream. Secondary colors are the results of mixing our primary colors.
3. You can make several color combinations, such as primary to primary, primary to secondary, or secondary to secondary. The color inside the box/rectangles will be your desired color.
4. Depending on the color you prefer, the approximate number of parts per color is provided. However, the actual color may differ from what appears in the color mixing guide due to temperature and consistency changes. If you see a darker or lighter shade than expected, feel free to customize your own color combination by adjusting the color ratio to reach the desired color.
5. Always try your mixture on a small, inconspicuous area and wait until it completely dries before evaluating the color match.
6. Clean the spatula after each use and between color changes. Rinse your brush with water after you have finished a layer of repair to prevent it from drying hard.
