## Shoe care with leather balm




### For continuous heavy-duty use

A shoe that is used intensively deserves good care. This ensures that it retains its shape as well as its water-repellent qualities, and, above all, its service life will be significantly extended. The leather balm is recommended for all models of shoes that are worn in severe conditions.

The leather balm should be applied to clean, dry shoes. We recommend treating the shoe before first use. Remove the shoelaces before treatment (except for BOA® closures), so that covered areas can be treated as well.

Rub the leather balm into the shoe with a sponge/cloth, with extra applied at the seams. Then use a hair dryer (make sure to always keep it in motion) to liquefy the balm on the shoe to ensure that the balm is deposited between the pores of the leather. This allows the leather balm to provide a better protective layer against, for example, sand, cement and heavy soiling. Wait until the leather balm draws in and allow to dry always naturally.

# **Shoe care with Waterproofer+ spray**



### Quick and easy maintenance

A quality shoe deserves good care. This ensures that it retains its shape as well as its water-repellent qualities, and, above all, its service life will be significantly extended. The Waterproofer+ is suitable for all shoes that see light use.

The waterproofing spray should be applied to clean, dry shoes. We recommend treating the shoe before first use.

Spray the shoe evenly from a distance of about 30 cm. Then let the shoe dry for at least 60 minutes. Only use the spray outdoors. The spray must not be used near an open flame (as it highly flammable!)
