- 4. Feel free to use paints & glue. We love things like fur, sequins, beads, googly eyes, ribbons, yarn, etc. Go wild! Please avoid using any real fur or feathers as these may cause allergies to students and staff. Also avoid using candy or other types of food as this can attract insects.
- 5. Bring your decorated pumpkin to the school entryway in the morning. There will be carts there for you to set them on. They will be displayed in the library.
- 6. Include entry form. Please do not attach name to pumpkin permanently in order to keep judging anonymous.
- 7. Deadline for entry is Oct. 28th. No late entries accepted. Judging will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. on October 29th.
