Activities and explorations for classes and groups

You can pick and adapt these activities as suits or if you'd prefer a structure for a class or session, take one activity from each group below.

Quick and fun activities and icebreakers

- What other transformative pies or foodstuff can you think up? Like Kraken crumble or jellyfish jelly. *Either as a full group activity, smaller groups or pairs.*
- Oleg calls Rory a chicken-gecko mashup. What are the funniest mashup animals you can think of? Can you draw any of them? As a variation everybody folds a page in half and draws the top half of a creature on the top half of their page then passes the paper to their left so everyone now has a different piece of paper. Then everyone draws the bottom half of their original creature on the bottom of that page.
- Rory gets turned into a dinosaur. What would you hate to be turned into? What would you love to be turned into? *Group discussion*
- Draw yourself as a dinosaur.
- Draw your pet (or any other animal) as a dinosaur.

Exploring facts and fiction

- This book is fiction. What does that mean? Discussion.
- Daria knows lots of facts. What facts do you know? What interesting facts do your classmates know?
 As a variation, everyone writes a fact or interesting thing and they all get stuck on a board titled Interesting Stuff We Know.

• Jebey, Rory's neighbour, talks about conspiracy theories? How do you fact check information you come across? Group discussion on the differences between fact, fiction and opinion.

Writing projects

 How do you think you would feel if you woke up transformed into a small, feathered dinosaur? What would your family think? What would your friends say? Could you make this idea into a story or poem?

As a variation: Turn this idea into a comic strip or group performance.

- Could you write the chapter *Chip Robbing Thugs* from Oleg's point of view? Or Daria's? Would they see things differently? Describe things differently? What would they think is important?
- In the book there is an "Everyone is so Absolutely Awesome" song. What do you think the words would be? Write it as a group activity.
