



2023 'First Session' Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc

Region

The Adelaide Hills is located in the Mount Lofty Ranges, east of Adelaide. One of the largest geographical wine regions in Australia; its diversity in terms of altitude, climate and soil helps it produce its distinctive cool climate wines.

Vintage

2023 was a cool and late vintage in the Adelaide Hills. Inconsistent weather throughout the vintage resulted in long cool ripening conditions and a later than usual harvest for the region. The 2023 vintage produced below average yields and with the late harvest into Autumn and the slow ripening process, the region maintained the high quality wines the area in renown for.

Wine

Fruit for the Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc was machine harvested in the early hours of the morning, then crushed and drained through the press to retain the fresh, bright flavours. Clarified juice fermented with two aromatic yeast strains to enhance the Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc varietal characters.

A fresh and floral Sauvignon Blanc with a zesty passionfruit and grapefruit nose, the mid palate is wonderfully textured with citrus pith and a long crisp finish. A perfect starter for a drink in the sun with friends. Pair with your favourite seafood dish.
