



2021 'Rianna' Fleurieu Peninsula Rosé

Region

Fleurieu Peninsula, a rugged, cool-climate coastal region of undulating terrain, rolling slopes, and gentle hills, poses no viticulture limitations. Arguably the best climatic conditions for producing table wines, the region yields a selection of fragrant, crisp whites and boasts aromatic reds of elegance.

Vintage

2021, a near-perfect vintage throughout all of South Australia, noticable especially in the Fleurieu Peninsula from pickings beginning in early February. Both yield and quality were exceptional. A wet winter allowed the vines to produce a good canopy, and a cool and dry summer provided slow, even ripening; enriching vibrant fruit flavour.

Wine

The juice was gently drained off the grapes that were picked in the cool of the morning to get low colour and phenolic extraction. A portion of the wine was fermented in old barrels to create textural features, whilst the remainder was fermented and clarified in tank to make a more aromatic component. The Rianna Rose is made in a fresh and dry style from predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon. Translucent pink in colour with scents of ripe strawberry followed by pomegranate, musk and spice. The palate is refreshingly clean with spicy cherry, raspberry and blood orange finish.
