





Installation Instructions


- **Step 1:** Open the carton and take out the parts. Check whether the number of components is complete.
- Step 2: Unplug the connector on the back side of the trailer plug and the parking sensor/license plate light connector. The parking sensor/license plate light connect sits right next to the trailer plug connector and is accessible from underneath the truck. (Figure 1)
- Step 3: Use the vehicle's key to unlock the spare tire lock and remove it from the OEM bumper. (Figure 2)




- Step 4: Remove the trailer plug from your OEM bumper by pressing in the tabs on the back side of the trailer plug and pushing the trailer plug out the front side of the bumper. (Figure 3)
- Step 5: Remove the metal bracket on the top side of the trailer hitch. Do this by using a 13mm to remove both mounting bolts. (Figure 4)



Step 6: There are two outer bumper mounting bolts per side. Use a 21mm Socket to remove these bolts. Then, remove the OEM bumper. (Figure 5~6)



Step 7: Remove the OEM Bumper Mounting Brackets. Use a 21mm Socket to remove the four mounting bolts (per side). Then, remove the brackets. (Figure 7)




- Step 8: Use a T30 Torx Socket to remove the plastic trim piece directly under the tailgate. (Figure 8)
- Step 9: Remove the parking sensors from their outer mounting rings. Do this by spreading the two tabs on the back side of the outer mounting ring. Then, push the sensor out the back side of the mounting ring. Leave the parking sensors plugged into the rear bumper wiring harness. Make sure to keep track of where each sensor was mounted on the OEM bumper. You have to mount them on your new bumper in the same order. (Figure 9)








- Step 10: Disconnect the license plate light plug from the parking sensor harness. (Figure 10)
- **Step 11:** Remove the license plate light housings from your OEM Bumper by pressing in the tabs on the back side of the housings and pushing the housings out the front side of the bumper. **(Figure 11)**




Step 12: Splicing the rear bumper.




















Step 14: Install the Shackles.




Step 15: Install the license plate light. Seat the clips when installed. (Figure 12~13)




Step 16: Install the spare tire lock. (Figure 14-15)



Step 17: Install the original 7-way trailer plug wiring harness. (Figure 16~17)




Step 18: Connect the Trailer plug wiring, 4inch Led lights and ⑦ Cabel wires.





Step 19: Install the Radar Probe.

NOTE: If the car does not have a radar probe, this step can be ignored.




Step 20: Install the Brackets.





Step 21: Installed the rear bumper on the car using the original bolts.



- Step 22: Plug in all connectors.
- Step 23: Stand back and enjoy your new Rear Bumper.
- **Step 24:** Check and re-tighten, if needed, all mounting bolts after 100 miles and periodically thereafter.

Step 25: The rear bumper is instaled.
