INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARATION:

Make sure you wear protective clothing and have a clock for timing as you will need to keep an eye on the time during toning.
Make sure you read all the instructions and know what you are doing before full head application.
You may require more than one kit if your hair is very long, thick or very healthy.
This product is to be applied as step two after bleaching your hair. Toners are used to create an even base.
Before toning your hair perform a strand test to make sure you're happy with the results.
Everyone's hair is different so results may vary.

- 60ml / 2.02 fl oz Developing Cream
- 60ml / 2.02 fl oz Colorant
- 20ml / 0.67 fl oz Hair Mask
- Pair of gloves

APPLICATION:



HAVE YOU DONE THE SENSITIVITY & STRAND TEST FIRST ?

(See other side of the page for **SENSITIVITY** and **STRAND** testing.)

1. Before applying the Toner Kit to your hair perform a strand test to make sure you're happy with the results. Everyone's hair is different so results may vary.
2. Protect your clothing and protect your hands with the gloves provided.
3. Comb hair into a centre part then divide into three sections – two ponytails at the side and one at the back.
4. Mix the colorant and developing lotion together in a plastic or porcelain bowl, then start application immediately.
5. Apply to dry hair using a tint brush or your hands covered in the protective gloves provided, from roots to ends, starting with each side ponytail before moving to the back. Gently massage the product into the hair.
6. Let the product develop for 5-10 minutes, checking every 5 minutes until you reach your desired colour. Do not exceed 30 minutes.
7. Keeping the gloves on your hands rinse in a way that minimizes contact with your face and body. Apply a small amount of hair mask or conditioner once your hair has been rinsed thoroughly. Leave for 5 - 20 minutes, rinse then dry and style as usual.
8. You can use this product after bleaching your hair or every three weeks to refresh the tone.

HAIR MASK

A nourishing hair mask with our bond building Briteplex to repair and strengthen your hair after lightening.

DIRECTIONS: After shampooing, work through damp hair. Concentrate on the ends. Leave for 10 to 20 minutes before rinsing.

A BIT MORE INFORMATION ABOUT TONING

Toners are to be used after hair lightening to provide tonal color. They can be used to adjust the color of your hair a little - to more cool or warm. The color will fade and is not permanent.

TIPS

The underlying color will impact the end result. For cool toners such as the silver you may need to follow with a purple shampoo if the color is too ash (green) for you. For warm toners such as the rose you will have a beautiful orange based rose on hair that still has orange or yellow tones.

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SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

In case of a reaction during the application such as:

Stinging, irritation, rash or burning sensation on the scalp, rinse immediately and discontinue use. Consult your doctor.

If you experience shortness of breath seek immediate medical attention before coloring your hair again, consult a doctor.

If, during the day following application, itching, redness or spots on the scalp and/or skin occurs, it is recommended that you consult a doctor.

Keep the empty package and this instruction leaflet for a few days in case you experience a reaction.

- Wear the gloves supplied in the carton.
- Remove all metal objects from hair before coloring and keep them away during coloring. Do not use metal styling tools.
- Prepare and apply the mixture in a well ventilated area.
- Avoid contact with eyes, ears and face. Do not use to dye eyelashes or eyebrows.
- This product contains ingredients which may cause severe eye irritation and possible permanent eye injury. Rinse the eyes immediately and thoroughly if the product comes into contact with them. If you wear contact lenses, take them out before rinsing your eyes thoroughly with water, In both cases, seek medical advice.
- Do not inhale or ingest.
- Do not use to dye a beard or moustache or for any other purpose than coloring your hair. Avoid any unnecessary contact with the skin.
- Rinse hair well after application.
- **Wait at least 2 weeks after using a relaxer, a perm or a straightening process on the hair before applying this colorant.**

Do not use if your hair has been colored with henna or with a progressive hair colorant. Keep developer away from heat and light. Do not mix this colorant with any other product. Do not keep any unused product. Do not leave the mixture in a closed bottle (the bottle may expand or burst).

Keep out of reach of children.

If coloring hair that is shoulder length or longer or thick you may need 2 or 3 packs.

SENSITIVITY TEST

Even if you have used this product before, check for sensitivities 48 hours before using this product.

Use a cotton bud dipped in alcohol to gently clean an area (about 1 cm) behind your ear, then dab on a small amount of colorant using the gloves provided. Wait 45 minutes then rinse off.

During the next 48 hours, if you experience any itching or redness in the test area, do NOT use this product.

You don't need to use the developing cream during the sensitivity test.

The sensitivity test helps detect those who are likely to develop allergies or a reaction from use. However, it is not a guarantee that a reaction, intolerance or allergy will not occur during the lightening process.

STRAND TEST

A strand test before application is always a good idea, even if you have used the product before.

Ensure that care is taken during application to prevent any unwanted coloring of clothing, floors, walls or soft furnishings.

Take a small section of hair from an area at the back of your head where your hair is the thickest. Make sure you take only a small sample and it is from an area where it will not be missed. Hair should be taken from a section similar to the hair you are coloring.

Protect clothing and put on the gloves provided. Mix together in plastic or porcelain bowl in equal quantities of the colorant cream and developing cream (you don't need much for the strand test).

Mix the product well then apply to the hair sample.

Leave for 30 minutes then wipe the hair clean to check color. Only proceed if you happy with the color. Please contact DM us for further advice if needed.

You must conduct an ALLERGY ALERT TEST 48 HOURS BEFORE each time you colour your hair even if you have already used this colouring product before.

Remember to buy the product 48 hours in advance (and read and follow the instructions). In case of any reaction or when in doubt, consult a doctor before using any hair colour product.

"Developer" contains hydrogen peroxide.

The colorant contains resorcinol, phenylenediamines (Toluenediamines).

Wear the gloves supplied in the box.

Avoid contact with eyes.

Do not use to dye eyelashes or eyebrow. Rinse the eyes immediately and thoroughly if the product comes into contact with them.

Rinse hair well after application. Wait at least 2 weeks after using a relaxer, perm or a straightening process on the hair.

Do not use if your hair has been colored with henna or with a progressive colorant.
