





# SETTING UP THE BATTLING ROBOTS



- 1. Turn off the power switch.
- 2. Turn the battery cover knob to open compartment.
- 3. Connect the battery wire to the robot's power connector as shown on the diagram.
- 4. Close the battery compartment and turn the power switch on.

# SETTING UP THE REMOTE CONTROLS

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver, unscrew the battery cover screw and open.
- 2. Install 2x new AA batteries taking care to match the correct polarity (+/-).
- 3. Close the cover and tighten the battery cover screw.

# CHARGING THE ROBOTS BATTERIES


- 1. Remove the battery from the robot as shown in the robot setting up instructions
- 2 Connect the robot battery to the USB charging cord connector.



- 4. The charger light will turn on to indicate charging. When the charger light goes out charging is complete and you can reinstall the battery in the robot.

Tip. Full charge takes approx. 1hr

## **OPERATING THE ROBOT**



#### Car & Robot Movement

Push the ①movement lever forward. the car or robot moves forward.

Pull the 1 movement lever backward. the car or robot reverses.









Push the ② turn lever to the left, the car or robot turns left




Push the ② turn lever to the right, the car or robot turns right.




#### Transforming between Car & Robot

Press the 4 transformation button, the car transforms into a robot.




Press the 3 transformation button, the robot transforms into a car.



## **BATTLING THE ROBOTS**


#### **Punching**

Press the **SLeft** Punch button, the robot punches with its left fist.





Press the © Right Punch button, the robot punches with its right fist.





Tip. You can only punch when transformed into the robot.

#### **Battle Mode**



Using both robots you can engage in a two player battle. The aim of the game is to get the robot to punch your opponents Attack Target. Land three successful punches and you are the winner!

Tip. The attack target doubles as an injury indicator and flashes with each successful punch.,
