Section 3: Potential Health Effects

Physical Description & Colour: Crème of pale white or yellow tone

Odour: Mild odour

Major Health Hazards: For professional use only and is a low hazard level. May cause slight stinging. May cause allergic reactions. Irritant to skin and eyes if contact occurs, there for careful observation of the instructions is mandatory and a sensitivity test is advisable. Keep out of reach of children.

Potential Health Effects

<u>Inhalation:</u> Short Term Exposure: Avoid breathing vapour.

Section 4: First Aid Measures

General Information:

Section 6: Accidental Release Measures

Accidental Release: This product is sold in small packages, and the accidental release from one of these is not usually a cause for concern. Section 10: Stability and Reactivity
