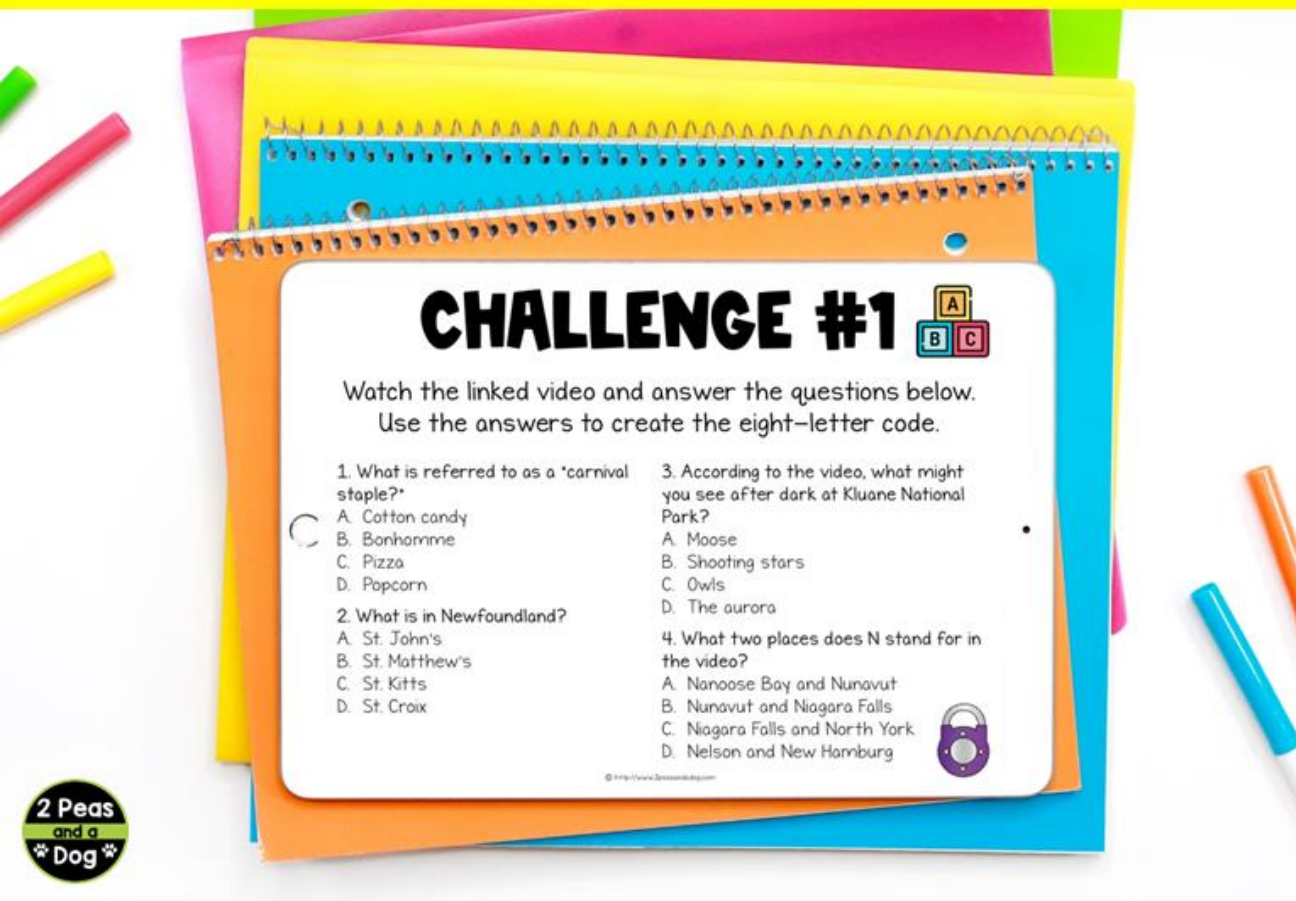

ESCAPE ROOM RULES

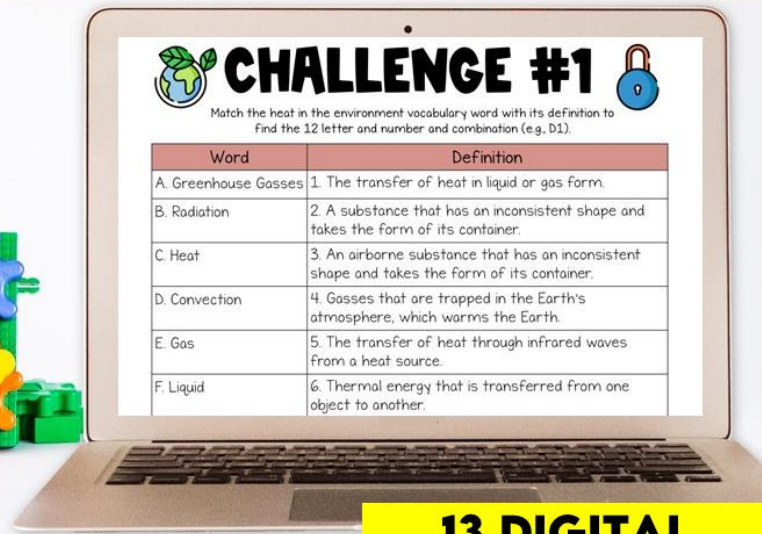

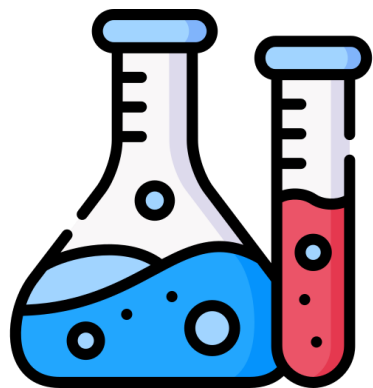
