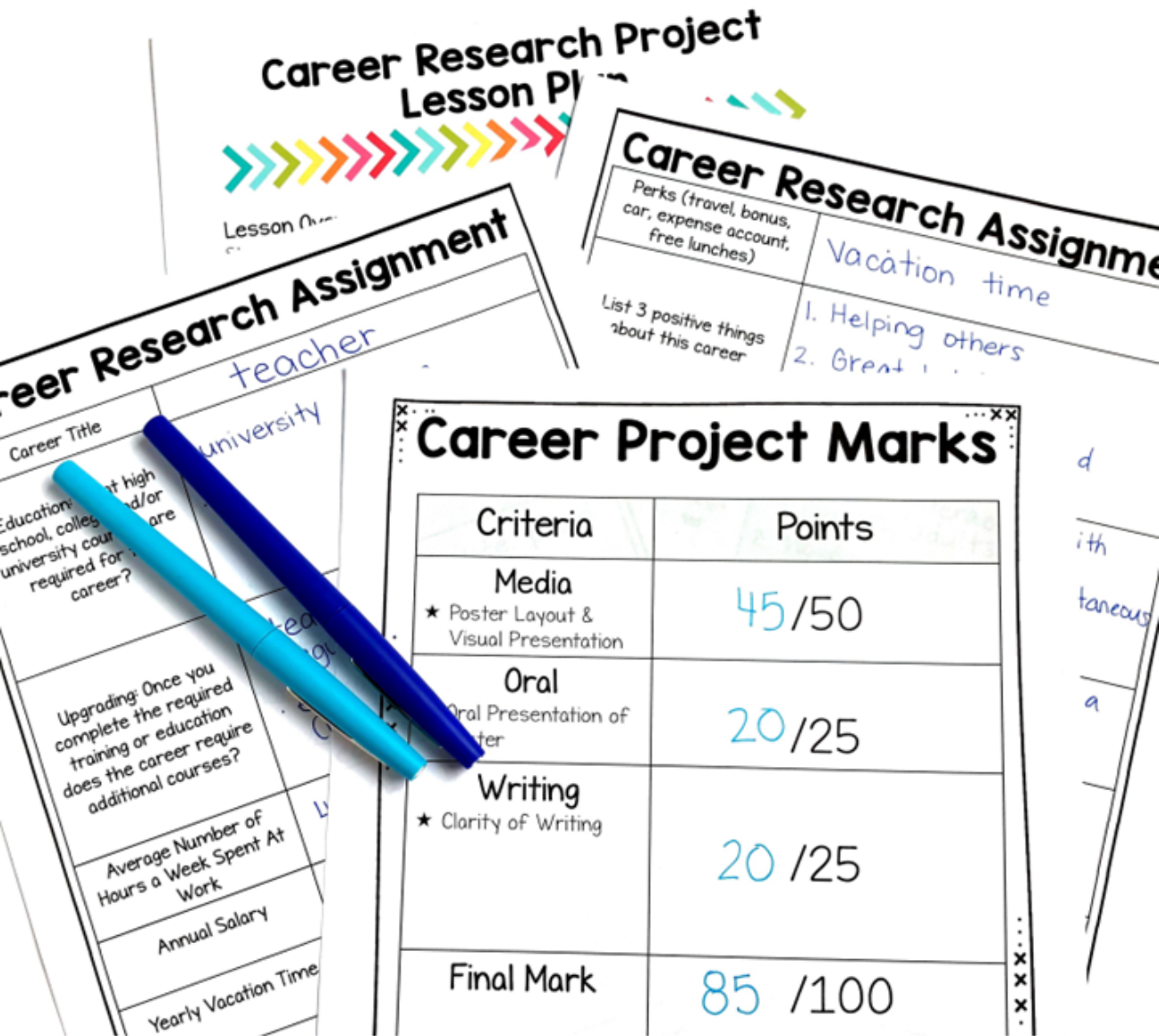
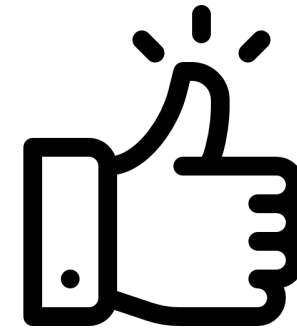

Lesson Overview:

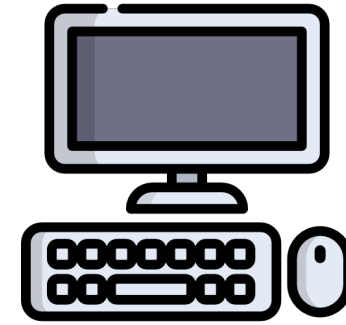
