

### **CANADIAN THANKSGIVING**

#### The Origins of Canadian Thanksgiving

Every year in October, Canadians celebrate Thanksgiving with friends and family. Before European explorers reached Canada, Indigenous Peoples held their own harvest celebrations in the fall.

Canadian Thanksgiving's roots go back to 1578. It has been said that English explorer Martin Frobisher and his crew gave thanks for their safe arrival at then-Frobisher Bay, present-day Nunavut.

The crew feasted on salt beef. biscuits and mushy peas and were thankful they had a safe arrival and for the food on their plates.

However, it wasn't until November 6, 1879, the first official Thanksqiving was celebrated. In 1957, Parliament officially declared Thanksgiving a holiday. Thanksgiving was to be celebrated on the second Monday of October every year.

It wasn't always celebrated in October, though. It was previously




