

CODE TALKERS

What Did They Say?

Using code, the talkers could share key information between military locations, such as the numbers of aircraft and bombers flying overhead and what kind they were.

They were able to share information about which supply lines to use and how to move troops, all key information for those on the battlefield

Some new meanings had to be created in the code, as the Cree language did not have words for items such as a machine gun or a tank. For example, a de Havilland DH.98 Mosquito Bomber plane was called a sakimes (which means






