How To Write A Thank You Card

Lesson Overview:

Students will work on their thank you card writing skills.

Required Materials:

- Video: [How to Write a Thank You Card](#)
- Internet access, projector, speakers
- Photocopy a class set or use the Google Slides version of: [How to Write a Thank You Card Handout](#)

DETAILED LESSON PLANS

2. Show students the video, How to Write a Thank You Card.
3. Hand out the 'How to Write A Thank You Card Notes' handout. Read through it as a class.
4. Then, demonstrate under a document camera how to write a thank you card.
5. Hand out the 'Thank You Card Brainstorm Sheet' and model for students how to complete the handout (There is an example included on the handout. It is one dog brother writing to another).
6. Pass out the templates to students and show them how to fold it into a card.

<p>What Is A Thank You Card?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A thank you card is a card in which you say thank you to someone. • Often, a person has done something for you or bought you something, or that you value their time. 	<h3>THANK YOU CARD BRAINSTORM SHEET</h3>	
<p>Why Is It Important To Write Thank You Cards?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank you cards are important in the digital age where everything is done online. People can feel lonely. • Thank you cards help people feel seen and valued. • Giving and getting a thank you card - it builds a connection between people. 		
<p>What Goes In A Thank You Card?</p>		<p>Brainstorm What You Want To Thank Them For (Circle Your Final Choice)</p>
