



- 2. Then, start the lesson by using the pre-listening questions to spark conversation about Halloween stores.
- 3. Next, ask students to fill out the Pre-Listening Cost of Living graphic organizer. Have a brief class discussion and write down some of the answers that students share.
- 4. Have the class listen to the brief segment "The spooky mystery of Halloween pop-up stores" from the Cost of Living Podcast Episode: "The terrifying tenancies of Halloween pop-up stores — and are bloodcurdling inflation rates a boogeyman?"
- 5. After listening to the podcast, have the students complete the Post-Listening graphic organizer.
