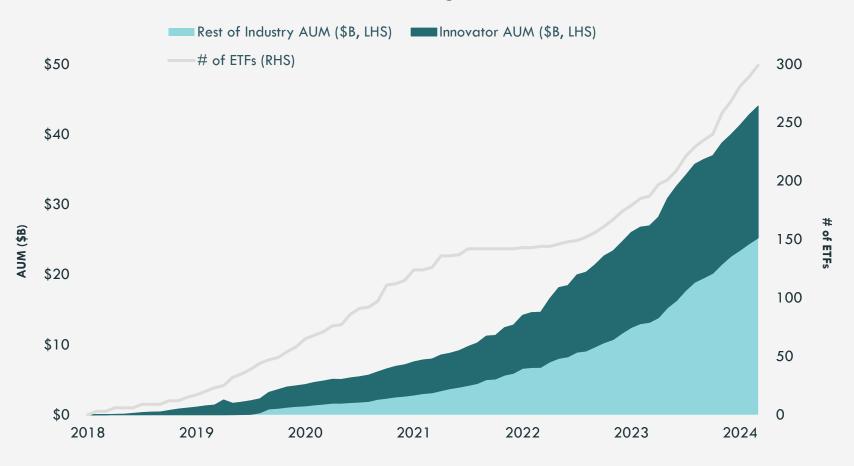

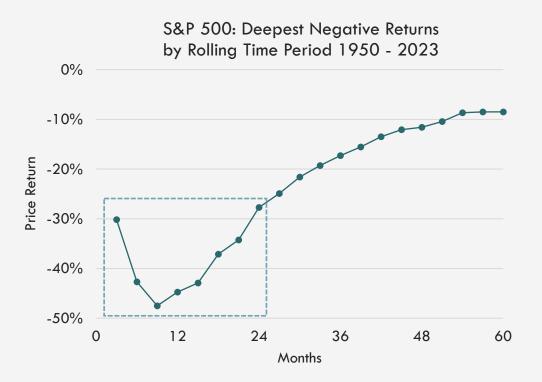

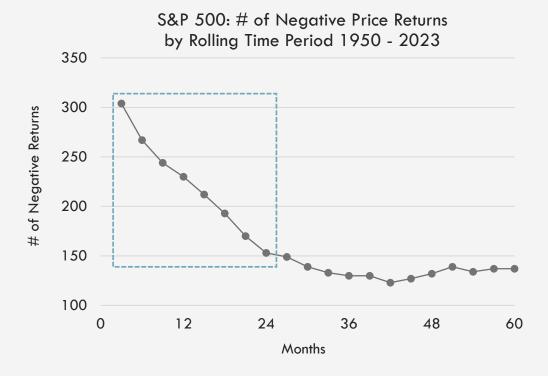
Negative Returns

Return Required to Breakeven From a Given Amount of Loss



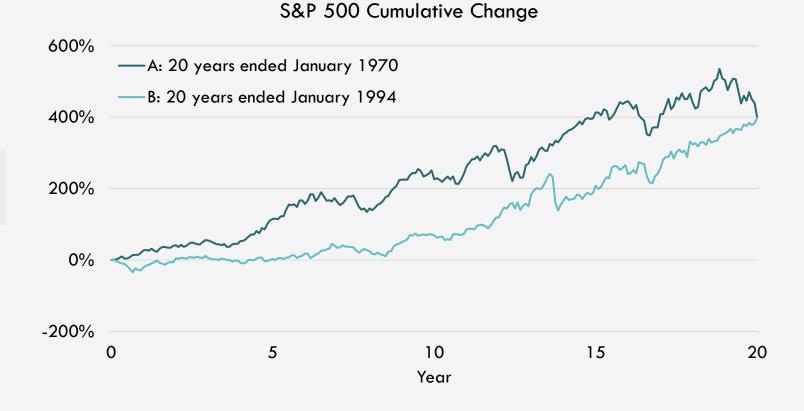

Sequence of Returns



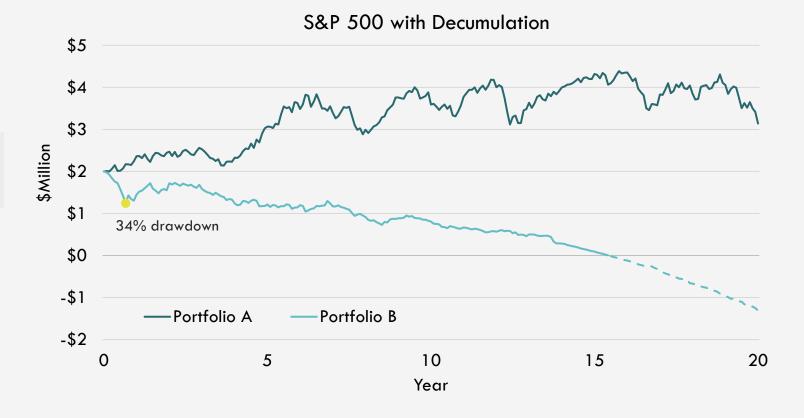
Same 20-year result. Very different paths.

Portfolio B runs out.



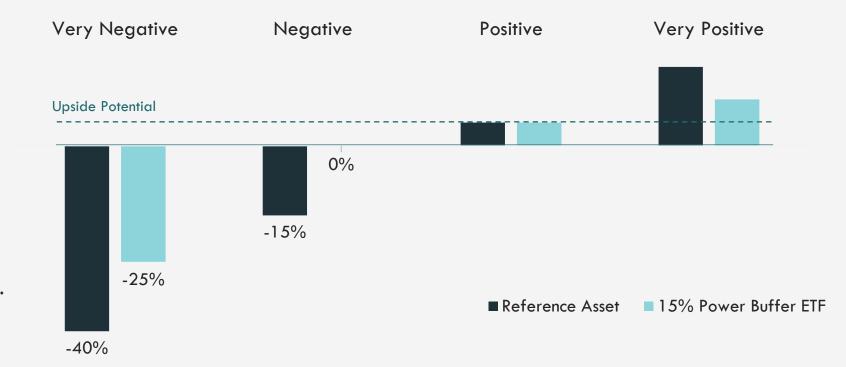

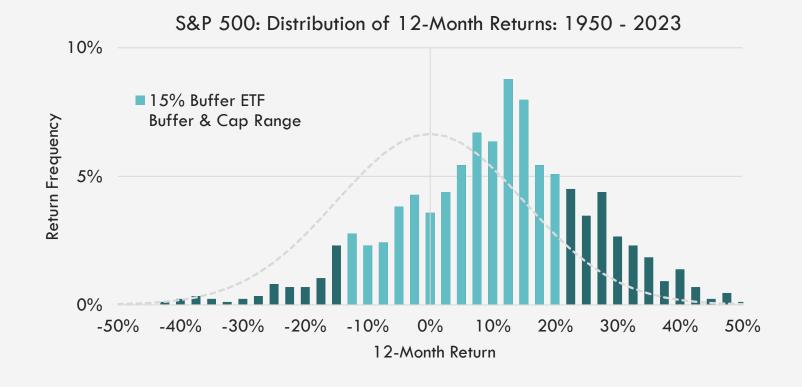
In this example of a 15% Buffer ETFTM, the market could fall by as much as 15% over the outcome period and the ETF would not incur a loss.

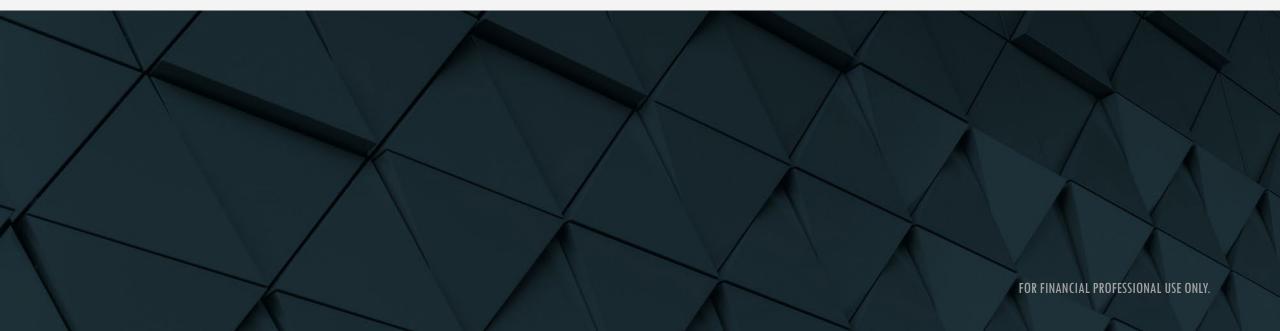
