Why the product is recalled: This product contains a button battery and there is a possibility that it does not comply to the new requirements which require the battery to be secured from a child accessing it easily.



Hazard: The danger includes that, should a child access the timer and manage to unhook the battery compartment door, then manage to dislodge the battery, the child may swallow the battery and in this case the battery can cause serious injury to the child. The ACCC advises that swallowing a button battery can lead to chemical burns, perforation of soft tissue, and death. Severe burns can occur within 2 hours of ingestion. Seek medical attention immediately.
