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# SCHOOLHOUSE KEG BOX DISPENSING

# **1. SCHOOLHOUSE KEG BOX**

- Best option for keeping beer cold, easy to dispense, and fresh.
- Can be used anywhere. No power is necessary. It will keep beer cold on the hottest days.

#### 1a. KEG BOX FEES

- Keg Box rental fee = \$20/ weekend (Friday to Tuesday)
- Deposit = \$100 for keg and associated dispensing equipment

#### **1b. KEG BOX COMPONENTS**

1. Keg Box

- 2. 20L keg of beer
- 3. Garbage bag
- 4. Bag of ice (customer responsibility)
- 5. CO2 bottle with regulator
- 6. Tri-clamp and gasket (often, these are attached to the CO2 regulator hose)



#### **1c. LOADING THE KEG BOX**

- 1. Open Keg Box
- 2. Put 20L keg (cold) in a garbage bag, then lift into the Keg Box
- 3. Connect tri-clamp and gasket to CO2 bottle line and CO2 line from keg coupler.
- 4. Connect keg coupler to keg
- 5. With the coupler handle in the up position line up the ears of the keg spear with notches in keg coupler
- 6. Turn coupler <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> turn to connect to keg, and push handle down.
- 7. Open CO2 bottle by turning the tap on top of the tank. Open small ball valve on the regulator. Pressure should be 10-12 PSI
- 8. Pour ice over the keg and coupler. Melting ice should be contained in the garbage bag lining the box
- 9. Close Keg Box, and guide the gas line through the notch in the lid.
- 10. Pour beer and enjoy.

#### 1i. TIPS

- Close the CO2 bottle when done serving for an extended time
- \*If you are having difficulty, call Cam at (902) 790 2364

# **3. RETURNING THE EQUIPMENT**

Best to return equipment during Taproom business hours: **11 a.m. - 8 p.m.**, **Tuesday to Sunday.** 

If returning equipment on a Monday (when the Taproom is closed):

- Come to the back loading bay door; production staff are working and can accept the equipment return
- \*Alternate arrangements may have to be made regarding the deposit refund if dropping off equipment on a Monday
