Kid's Trivia Plus

3rd Edition Rules

Aim:

to be the first player to successfully arrive at the Finish line on the board.

To Start:

All players roll the die, the highest roller starts. In the event of a tie, the leading players roll as many more times as it takes to find a winner.

All players choose their playing token.

The trivia cards are placed in a pile by the side of the playing board Play proceeds in a clockwise direction.

On their turn, a player rolls the die and advances their token that number of squares along the board. If they land on a School, Riddles, World or Telling Tales square, the player to their left picks up the top card and reads out the relevant question on the bottom side of the card.

Telling Tales – This requires an explanation.

School – This is a trivia question to answer.

Riddles – $\mathbf{?}$ This is a riddle to guess.

Today's Trivia – 🏠 This is a question about the world or players around you.

If at least half the other players like your explanation, or if a player answers one of the other categories correctly, the answering player can roll again and move that number of spaces forward. This ends their turn.

If, on the first roll of a turn, a player lands on a Your Choice square, the player can choose the category to answer.

If, on the first roll of a turn, a player lands on a Roll Again square, the player rolls again, answers the relevant Question and, if they get it correct have their final roll.

After the first player has finished their turn, play passes to the player on their left.

To Win: The first player to cross the Finish line is the winner.

N.B. In the event of a disagreement as to the correct interpretation of the rules, a majority vote wins!
