

A GAME FOR 2 OR MORE PLAYERS OR TEAMS AGES 6+ YEARS

Object

To have the highest score after 5 rounds of play by correctly guessing the hidden picture in the quickest time.

To Set Up

Place the boxes of cards on the table, close the iris on the Eye Opener device and write each player or team name on the score pad provided.

To Play

The person who bought the game gets the chance to guess first as they are indeed wise and have shown great good taste. The player to their right secretly puts a card into the device and shows the picture to the other players. Ensuring the iris is closed the device is then passed to the guesser. The guesser then slowly opens the eye to reveal the picture. The guesser can have as many guesses as they like, all the time opening the eye a little more. Once they have guessed correctly the device is flipped over to reveal the score between 1 and 5. The score is revealed by the pointer – note, if the pointer is between numbers the higher of the 2 numbers counts. Only once the pointer passes the line between numbers does the lower number count as the score. The score should then be recorded on the score pad provided. Note, if there are more than 6 players or teams, use the reverse of the score pad to note the score. For the next round the player to the left of the original judge becomes the new judge and play continues in this fashion. Once everyone has had one turn at being the guesser, the first round is over.

Winning The Game

Play continues for 5 rounds following the above rules and the scores are totalled and the player with the most points is declared the winner.

Variation

All Play. The judge inserts the card into the Iris and, in full view of all the other players, very slowly opens the Iris revealing the picture. All the other players shout out answers until one of them has a correct guess. Their score is noted and that player then becomes the judge for the next round. As soon as any player has 5 correct guesses, the game ends and the scores are added up. The player with the highist score wins.
