HOW TO PLAY

- The first player takes a Subject Card and lays it face up for all players to see.
- 2. That player starts at the letter "A," saying a word that fits the category on the Card. (For Example: if the category is Animals, a player might say "Ant.")
- 3. The player to the left then says a word starting with "B," the next with "C" and so on, making their way through the alphabet.



INSTRUCTIONS

CONTENTS

70 Subject Cards, 30 Trick Cards

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Be the player with the fewest Trick Cards at the end of the game.

SET UP

Shuffle the cards and place them face down in two piles, one for Subject Cards and one for Trick Cards. (There are blank Subject and Trick Cards for players to add their own personal twists!)

- If players stumble or hesitate, they are out of the round and must pick up a Trick Card.
- 4. The round continues until players reach "Z," or all players have stumbled and picked up a Trick Card,
- 5. On the next round (a new Subject Card), players with a Trick Card must incorporate the Trick when it is their turn.

WINNING THE GAME

Once all Trick Cards have been drawn, the player with the fewest Trick Cards wins!
