The use of calculators is not permitted when answering numerical questions, which are designed to test your aptitude when working with numbers as well as your powers of mental arithmetic.

If you have time to spare at the end of the test use the extra time to quickly review your answers. You do not get any extra marks for finishing early! We've all been guilty of slips of the pen at one time or another and this may well be one of those occasions!
