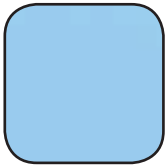

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42 " wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

WOF= Width of fabric.

RST = Right sides together

Fabric A

- Cut five 10"x WOF strips.
 - Sub-cut into twenty 10" x 10" squares

Fabric B (Panel)

- Cut six 10" x 10" squares from panel

Fabric C

- Cut six 10" x 10" squares

Fabrics D & E

- Cut two 10-3/4" x WOF strips
 - Sub-cut into six 10-3/4" x 10-3/4" squares
 - Sub-cut each square from corner to corner into four triangles
- * A total of twenty-two triangles is needed of each color.*

Fabric F & G:

- Cut two 10-3/4" x WOF strips
 - Sub-cut into five 10-3/4" x 10-3/4" squares
 - Sub-cut each square from corner to corner into four triangles
- * A total of fourteen triangles is needed of each color*

Fabric H:

- Cut two 10-3/4" x WOF strips
 - Sub-cut into five 10-3/4" x 10-3/4" squares
 - Sub-cut each square from corner to corner into four triangles
- * A total of eighteen triangles is needed*

Fabric I:

- Cut one 10-3/4" x WOF strip
 - Sub-cut into three 10-3/4" x 10-3/4" squares
 - Sub-cut each square from corner to corner into four triangles
- * A total of ten triangles is needed*

Fabric J, K, L:

- Cut one 10-3/4" x WOF strip
 - Sub-cut into two 10-3/4" x 10-3/4" squares
 - Sub-cut each square from corner to corner into four triangles
- * A total of eight triangles is needed of each color*

Step 1. Assemble the Blocks

Construct the quarter square triangle blocks by pairing fabrics together as instructed below and sewing RST along a short side. Take care to note which fabric should be on the left of the pair.

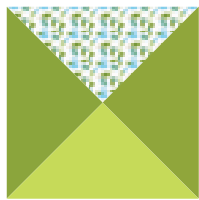

- fourteen E/G triangles, Fabric E on the left (shown in fig. 1)
- two E/L triangles, Fabric E on the left
- six E/J triangles, Fabric E on the left
- ten H/I triangles, Fabric H on the left
- four H/L triangles, Fabric H on the left
- two H/J triangles, Fabric H on the left
- two H/K triangles, Fabric H on the left
- fourteen D/F triangles, Fabric D on the left
- six D/K triangles, Fabric D on the left
- two D/L triangles, Fabric D on the left

Press all seams to the darker fabric

Following placement shown in Quilt Assembly Diagram (found on page 5), pair triangle units together to form thirty-two quarter square triangle blocks (fig. 2). Nest seams and sew, RST, along longest side of the unit.

Tip: Lay out entire quilt before sewing to ensure pairs are in the correct place.

For all thirty-two quarter square triangle blocks, press final seams open and trim blocks to 10" x 10" square.

Step 2. Assemble the Quilt

Sew blocks together into nine rows of seven blocks each, referencing Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward the darker fabric.

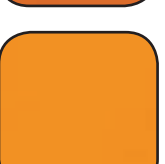
Nesting seams, sew rows together to assemble quilt top. Press seams open.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
