## Quilt Top Assembly:

## 1. Quilt Center Assembly

a. Arrange and sew together ( $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares of appropriate fabrics and ( $11 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ ") sashing rectangles into rows, as shown.

b. Arrange and sew together 7 ( $11 / 2$ " x 4 1/2") 1895-2 rectangles from cut appropriate fabrics and 6 ( $11 / 2$ ") 185231 squares to make Sashing Row 1:

c. Arrange and sew together the rows to complete quilt center in the following order:Row 1 - Sashing Row 1 Row 2 - Sashing Row 2 - Row 3 - Sashing Row 3 - Row 4 - Sashing Row 4 - Row 5 - Sashing Row 5 - Row 6 Sashing Row 6 - Row 7

2. Inner Border \#1.
a. Sew $2(11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 ") 1896-1$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 ( $11 / 2$ " x 36 1/2") 1896-1 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

3. Inner Border \#2.
a. Making Ohio Star block, using (1848-03 / 1850-02 / 1897-1) as example.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (4 1/4") 1897-1 square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 ( $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ) 1850-02 square. Sew 1/4" away from, on the right and left sides of, drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two halfsquare triangle units (HST).

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 HST unit. With contrasting triangle patches, place 1 HST on the other HST, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from, on the right and left sides of, drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two quarter-square triangle units (QST). Repeat to make a total
of four QST units.


Arrange and sew into a row 2 (3 1/2") 1850-02 squares and 1 QST unit. Repeat to make a total of two rows.


Arrange and sew into a row 1 (3 1/2") 1848-03 square and 2 QST units.


Sew rows together to complete Ohio Star block center.

b. Add 1 (3 1/2" x $61 / 2$ ") 1848-03 rectangle to the top of block center.


Add 1 (3 1/2" x 9 1/2") 1848-03 to the left of the block center to complete 1 block.

c. Repeat to make a total of four blocks in the following colorways, noting the placement of Ohio Star block center if
fabrics are directional.

d. Arrange and sew the blocks into columns, and add to the left and right sides of quilt center.


e. Arrange and sew the blocks into rows, and add to the top and bottom sides of quilt center.


## 4. Inner Borders \#3, \#4, \#5.

a. \#3. Sew 2 (2" x $541 / 2$ ") $1854-5$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 ( 2 " x $571 / 2$ ") 1854-5 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
b. \#4. Sew 2 (1" x $571 / 2$ ") 1850-02 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1"x 58 1/2") 1850-02 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
c. \#5. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x $\left.581 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ 1896-2 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 ( $11 / 2$ " x $601 / 2 "$ ) 1896-2 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

5. Inner Border \#6.
a. Making Shoo Fly block, using 1851-02 block as example.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (27/8") 185404 square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (27/8") 1851-02 square. Sew 1/4" away, on right and left sides of, drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield 2 HST units. Repeat to make a total of 4 HST units.


Sew 2 HST units and 1 ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 2 1/2") 1850-04 rectangle into a row, as shown. Repeat to make a total of two rows.


Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") 1850-04 rectangles and 1 (1 1/2") 1851-02 square into a row.

Arrange and sew the blocks together to complete one block.

b. Repeat to make a total of blocks in the following colorways. Only the varying sku is listed (the 1850-04 and 1854-04 patches remain the same.

c. Making Diamond in Square block, using 1850-02 / 1897-

2 block as example.
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (3") 1850-02 square. Place square, right sides together, at one corner of 1 ( $51 / 2$ ") 1897-2 square. Sew on drawn line. Trim1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal 1850-02 corner triangle. Repeat with three additional (3") 1850-02 squares for the remaining corners of the same ( $51 / 2$ ") 1897-2 square to complete one diamond in square block.

d. Repeat to make a total of blocks in the following colorways.

2 blocks/ 1850-02 \& 1897-2


2 blocks/ 1850-01 \&1897-1


2 blocks /1850-03 \& 1897-1


4 blocks/ 1851-11\&1895-1


4 blocks/ 1849-02 \& 1896-1


4 blocks/ 1851-01 \& 1899-1


4 blocks/ 1849-02 \& 1895-1


4 blocks/ 1851-03 \& 1899-1

e. Arrange and sew blocks into columns and add to the left and right sides of quilt center.
f. Arrange and sew blocks into rows and add to the top and bottom sides of quilt center.


## 6. Inner Border \#7 and Outer Border.

a. \#7. Sew 2 ( $11 / 2$ " x $701 / 2$ ") $1897-1$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x $721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) 1897-1 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center. b. Outer. Sew 2 ( 3 " x 72 1/2") 1849-03 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3"x 77 1/2") 1849-03 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.


Finishing
Layer, baste and quilt as desired.
Attach binding.
