TIPS & TRICKS

- Dip your Eco Cutter into flour or cooking oil before using sticky dough or clay to help with a clean cut out and imprint.
- Use a toothpick or pencil to push out any stuck dough or clay in the more intricate Eco Cutters.
- Clean our Eco products with cold soapy water only, do not place in dishwasher or hot water as our biodegradable products will begin to melt.





3 WAYS TO USE ECO CUTTERS

- Invite your little friends to fill their chosen Eco Cutter up with waterbeads.
- Create hanging ornaments out of air drying clay. Be sure to dip the Eco Cutters in flour or cooking oil to avoid the clay sticking to the cutter.
- Match the chosen Eco Cutter with the correct shape on our scenery play mats.

3 WAYS TO USE ECO STAMPS

- Invite your little ones to spell their names using the Eco Stamps.
- Letter recognition - write out words and encourage your little ones to find the matching letter using the Eco Stamps.
- Improve fine motor skills by encouraging your little ones to change the stamp they want on the handle.

3 WAYS TO USE ECO BUBBLE WANDS

- Encourage story creation by blowing the bubbles and ask each little one to tell you where that bubble went.
- Encourage shape recognition and ask what shape each bubble is making and what part of nature it looks like.
- Improve balance and gross motor development by encouraging the little ones to catch the bubbles.
