WOOD FINISH CARE GUIDELINES

To preserve the unique beauty of our oil rubbed walnut and white oak solid woods, we recommend simple maintenance techniques, such as protecting your custom furniture pieces from direct sunlight, which may fade the distinct finish. Do not use furniture polishes or bleach-based cleaners, which can lead to tarnishing. Erica Tanov cannot guarantee the results of other cleaning products.

When needed, gently wipe the wood with a dry lint-free cloth. For heavier stains, a mild diluted soap may be used with a gentle lint-free cloth. To touch up scratches, apply a natural wood finishing oil to a clean cotton cloth and gently buff.

MOHAIR VELVET CARE GUIDELINES

Pressure marks may present in mohair velvet after handling and transport. These marks may gradually disappear and can be diminished though gentle steaming, delicate vacuuming, or brushing. To maintain the mohair velvet pile, which will change over time and use, we recommend regular gentle combing with a fine-tooth comb designed specifically for use on velvet.
