The Islamic Resource Corner is an open-source platform designed to serve as a central hub for Islamic educational resources. It offers a variety of content for download, while also allowing users to upload their own materials to benefit others.

Users can search for various types of content, including PDFs, videos, and interactive tools like Kahoot!. The platform aims to enhance teaching materials with interactive elements, creative art lessons, audio/visual content, and other scholar-reviewed resources, fostering a collaborative environment for educational enrichment.

The Islamic Resource Corner boasts an extensive collection with over 250 resources currently available, with more than 50 vendors already registered. The platform has seen significant engagement, with over 600 items downloaded by over 200 customers. This highlights the platform's role as a valuable and widely utilized hub for Islamic educational materials.

ELMS - PAKISTAN

Networking packages that include the Islamic Curriculum and Kisa Publications have been sent out to numerous schools and madressas. We have partnered with Prosper to launch a school in D.I.KHAN.

Al-Kisa Foundation will be partnering with Educational Leadership and and Management System (ELMS) in Pakistan to launch a School Transformation Program that local schools can benefit from.

Al-Kisa Foundation and ELMS will be hosting a summit in Murree, Pakistan on June 22 - 25th, 2024 for school leadership with over 30 schools invited.



KISA EAST AFRICA

Over 7000 books were distributed to schools, Madaris and Professionals across Kenya and Tanzania.

A leadership summit was held in August whereby 80 plus leaders attended from different schools and organizations across Kenya and Tanzania.

A training was held for Admin and teachers at WIPAHS whereby over 120 teachers from Kenya and Tanzania Benefitted.

Al Kisa Foundation has signed an MOU with WIPAHS to take over Wali ul Asr School in Dar es Salaam for a period of 10 years and will be the first lighthouse school for the AKES.

AKES Team evaluated over 10 schools across Kenya and Tanzania which will also undergo the transformation program.



In alignment with our commitment to continuous learning and holistic well-being, we initiated weekly holistic training sessions led by Dr. Kauthar Khan this year, focusing on various aspects of mental health. These sessions provide our therapists with valuable insights and tools to enhance their clinical skills and promote holistic healing approaches.

4 - Establishment of Marketing Team

To strengthen our brand presence and effectively communicate our mission and services, we created a dedicated marketing team. This team is working to foster community engagement and amplify our outreach efforts across multiple channels.

5 - Promotion at IMI Canada National Conference 2023



RISE Academy, a private faith-based institution operating within the RISE Education System in San Jose, California and has been a pillar in the community since its establishment in 2009. Our institution caters to students from Toddler to 12th grade and holds accreditation from

both the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and Cognia (International accreditation). RISE is one of 15 Islamic schools in the entirety of the San Francisco Bay Area and only one of three that offers a high school program. The Academy is completing its 16th school year with an enrollment of more than 230 students across its Early Childhood Education (ECE), Elementary, Middle, and Secondary programs.

MILESTONES

In May 2024, RISE Academy hosted three members of a Western Association for College and Schools (WASC) Visiting Committee for a duration of three and a half days. The purpose of the Committee's visit was to conduct a thorough review of all areas of the RISE Academy and RISE Institute's academics, policies, leadership, governance, programs, and future plans. The accreditation visit involved classroom observation, staff/student/parent/board interviews, and the evaluation of a 94-page self-study document. Alhamdulillah, the visit was very successful. RISE has achieved maximum accreditation recommendation and an overall ranking of "highly effective" in the vast majority of all focus areas! The WASC accreditation has been renewed for the next six years.

In June 2024, our 15 12th graders will insha'Allah join the ranks of our alumni as the fourth class to graduate from the Academy. All students in the official graduation stream have secured admission to universities and college, including institutions such as University of California - Berkeley, University of California - Davis, University of California - Los Angeles, San Jose State University, and St. Mary's, including one student who received a \$116,000 scholarship to St. Mary's.

In the academic year of 2023-2024, one of our students achieved the distinction of becoming a finalist and ultimately won the National Merit Scholarship. This prestigious award was a result of his exceptional performance on the PSAT/NMSQT, where he scored in the 99th percentile, showcasing his outstanding academic talents and dedication.

RISE Academy students placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd across various age categories in the international annual Urwatul Wuthqa Qur'an competition that took place in April, 2024.



RISE Institute is a US-based, nationally accredited online school that strives for the development of the whole child by providing excellence in academic preparation in a faith-based environment. This means that in addition to the core subjects of Reading, Writing, Math, Science and Social Studies, we integrate Qur'ān, Islamic Studies, and Mentorship to develop students towards high levels of God-consciousness, professional excellence and civic leadership by serving the larger society around them.

RISE Institute offers a holistic education that incorporates the teachings of the Ahl al-Bayt, where teachers utilize critical thinking that allow students to find creative solutions to real world issues. RISE Institute gives a voice to all students with small class sizes, personalized learning experiences, and leadership opportunities.

MILESTONES

- 1 RISE Institute creates a holistic learning environment through Islamic, academic, enrichment, and social opportunities for every student, through our daily assemblies, after school clubs, schoolwide competitions and events, and facilitation in-person gatherings in large cities.
- 2 RISE Students participated in a variety of competitions including a schoolwide Spelling Bee, Urwathul Wuthqa Quran Competition, and WISE Talks International Speech Competition.
 - For the WISE Talks Competition, two RISE students joined their peers from 27 schools competing in Karbala, Iraq. Our 5th grade student placed 3rd in the 10-14 age group in the competition presenting her topic about water conversation.
 - During the Urwathul Wuthqa Quran Competition RISE Institute competed alongside 11 other registered students from across the globe for the second annual Qur'an Competition. RISE had 7 students placed as finalists, and the school was recognized as one of the two top schools in the competition.

21 RISE INSTITUTE

- 3 RISE Institute students showed scholastic and academic success in our school assessments and presentations.
 - In our NWEA MAP Benchmarking Assessment, RISE analyzed the student data and 100% of the classrooms are achieving at or above grade level.
 - STREAM Fair: A Celebration of Learning is an annual program where students submit proposals for projects they have done during the year, and present to the school their project, sharing what they learned, and making Islamic connections to their work.
 - RISE hosts Student-Led Conferences twice per year to give students the opportunities to share their personal goals with their parents and progress towards those goals. Learning Coaches (parents) shared 100% satisfaction rate that Student-Led Conferences are both beneficial to them and to their learners.







- 4 RISE Institute has a fully Muslim Teaching Staff that shares a collective 75+ years of experience, 100% of the staff have Bachelor's Degrees and/or educational certifications, 100% of the staff are Project Based Learning Certified, and 50% of staff have obtained Graduate Degrees.
- 5 RISE Families shared their overall satisfaction rate with our school is 9 out of 10, highlighting the nurturing of future Muslim leaders, creating a safe and Islamically aligned environment, notable student growth while at RISE, and compassionate and dedicated teaching staff.



RISE MicroSchools are an opportunity for our RISE Institute families to gather on a regular basis to provide the students with religious, social, and academic enrichment. The RISE MicroSchools will be using programs created by the RISE team and in line with the mission and vision of the school. MicroSchools are established in communities of our RISE Institute families who are interested in providing this program for their children.

A RISE MicroSchool benefits the whole community! RISE students can spend time together while sharing their love of learning and the Ahl al-Bayt. RISE MicroSchools located in Islamic centers will encourage students to participate in local programs while enjoying time with their friends. RISE MicroSchools are building blocks for community schools.



MILESTONES

- 1 RISE Institute and the MicroSchools hosted several hybrid events this year including games day, annual schoolwide mailis, and the school showcase.
- 2 At Phoenix and Simi Valley MicroSchools students take their core classes online with RISE Institute teachers and have recess, lunch, extra curricular activities, Islamic celebrations & commemorations with their peers at the in-person facility. MicroSchools are a unique place where students receive the high quality education from credentialed and experienced RISE Institute teachers and enjoy the social aspect of in person schools.
- 3 RISE Phoenix in Arizona launched this year with 25 students with 15 families. The facility has 2 classrooms designed with the RISE students in mind. There are 4 learning coaches on staff that work with the students while at the MicroSchool.
- 4 RISE Simi Valley MicroSchool program is in their second year and doubled their enrollment from last year to this year, there are currently 12 students in Kindergarten to Grade 4.





5 RISE Seattle in Washington continued their third year and is looking forward to continuing to expand their program next year. RISE Institute has 19 students living in the Seattle area who have access to their program. The Seattle Program students are engaged in a diverse range of activities including science experiments focusing on macromolecule identification, crafts such as decoupage rocks and creating thank you cards, life skills like food preparation and safe can opening, and physical education involving circuits, team building activities, soccer, yoga, and various fun games to conclude the school year. Next year the team has secured a facility that can be open to RISERs 3 days a week!

RISE East Bay has a beautiful campus and yard, and the curriculum emphasizes nature-based learning and play.









MILESTONES

We have expanded our academic offerings by adding new grades up to 2nd grade, providing a broader educational scope.

The completion of Phase 2 of playground renovations marks a significant milestone, with the introduction of new play structures enhancing recreational facilities.

We have commenced horseback riding classes for Elementary kids, enriching our extracurricular program with diverse activities.

Our students continue to excel academically, consistently outperforming national scores on the MAP Growth NWEA assessment for grades 1-2.

In addition to academic achievements, we have introduced Lego engineering classes on a weekly basis for grades 1-2, fostering hands-on learning experiences.

We are proud to announce the successful implementation of a fully project-based learning curriculum, encompassing various enriching activities:

- Weekly Lego engineering classes tailored for grades 1-2.
- A revitalized gardening program offering weekly classes focused on planting and growth from seed.
- Engaging hands-on science units covering diverse themes such as Ramadan and water conservation.

Graduate students are currently enrolled in the Practicum course. The course is co-taught by Dr. Nooh Kasraie and Dr. Taymaz Tabrizi. In the practicum course the students will be working in an organization for 60 hours and applying the theories and concepts they have learned into practice.

In this course, enrolled students are volunteering their expertise in six different non-profit organizations with an economic impact of more than \$12,000.

RISE University is planning an open house to recruit its first batch of international students for the Fall 2024 semester.

The USA has the highest incarceration rate in the entire world. Americans only represent 5% of the entire world's population, but its inmates comprise nearly 25% of the entire world's incarcerated population. That is 2.3 million inmates.

Without proper access to educational resources, most of these individuals will fall victim to the cycle of the revolving door and become repeat offenders.

2nd Chance seeks to provide the proper tools for change. Our initiatives aim to promote awareness of the true teachings of Islam through the moral and ethics teachings of the Noble Prophet (s) and his divine household (a) in our program.


