Thank you for purchasing the Liberty Watch-Phone with GPS Location from WatchOvers Limited. For best use of the Liberty watch, please read the following instructions carefully before starting and operate the watch accordingly. Screens may vary for Android and iOS.

Note: A copy of these instructions are in the “Help” section of our App.



Speaker: Do not cover the speaker when calling.

MIC: Do not cover the Mic when calling.

Charging: Pivot open the cover to connect power lead.

Power button: The watch can be powered off by pressing the pinhole behind the charging door using a pin.

SOS/Dialling/Answer: This is multi-function button;

- SOS Call - Press and hold the button for 3 seconds.
- Answer Call – One short press of the button.
- End Call – One short press of the button.
- Display Screen – One short button press.
- Scroll Contacts – One short button press.
- Dial Contact – Press and hold the button for 3 seconds when contact is highlighted.

Subscriptions

Your watch comes with a SIM card built in. Before you start please activate your SIM card by going to:

Operation Guide

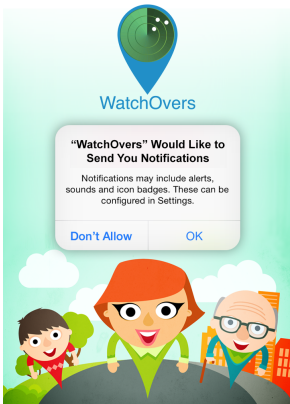
Important: When adding telephone numbers to the App, best practice is to use your international code +44 or +353.

Power on: Press the SOS/Dialling/Answer button for 3 seconds to power on the watch.

Note: The watch will not shutdown unless the battery is without charge.

Installing the App: Scan the QR code on the bottom of the box with your mobile phone or go to the download section of our website at <http://www.watchovers.com/download/apps/> to download our WatchOvers App.

After installing our App, please say “OK” to push notificatons, to allow you to receive notificatons and messages from the watch.



Swipe the screen left to go to the 2nd screen and press the “Start” button to enter the App.

Press “Create New Account” button and enter your information when prompted. If you have an account already set up, manually enter your own mobile phone number (not the watch phone number), enter your password and click “sign in” to login.

Settings

- Set and Edit your (the parent/guardians) basic information such as your Photo (optional), your Name, your Gender.
- Notification settings:
 - “Notification Message” Ensure this is turned on to receive any messages from the watch.
 - Notification Type:
 - “Sound” Ensure this is turned on to receive any


audio notifications to your phone.

- “Vibrate” Optional: Turn on to receive any vibration notifications to your phone.

Add the Watch to the App

Click the  symbol in the App or swipe left on the screen to enter the management screen.

Click “Add” on the top right of the screen and scan the serial number bar code on the bottom of the box or manually enter the watch device serial number to add the watch (do not enter the letters “S/N”, just enter the number)

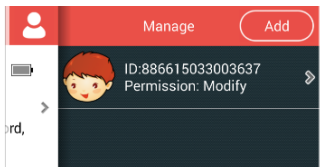

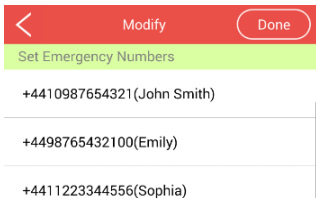
Manage Watches

To Edit or Delete any information on the watch such as pre-set



numbers, SafeZones, Alarm clock etc. touch on the area on the screen to Modify the information.

Emergency numbers:



Three Primary numbers can be set that the wearer can call for help by pressing the SOS dialling

button for 3 seconds in the case of an emergency. The watch will dial these 3 numbers one by one, twice. An SOS notification message will also be sent to everyone that has that watch paired to the App. The watch will stop dialling once the call has been connected to any of the numbers.

Friend's numbers:

5 additional numbers can be set which are allowed to call the watch and the watch can call them. The list of friends' numbers

will be displayed by short pressing the dialling button, one press at a time, to scroll down. Select the highlighted number and press the dialling button for 3 seconds to dial that number.

Silent monitoring numbers:

The silent monitoring numbers and SOS number/friends numbers can be same. If your mobile number is set as a monitoring number only (not an SOS or a friends number), when you dial from your phone, it will make a silent monitoring call and when you press "call" in the app, it will also make a silent monitoring call.

If your mobile number is set as both a silent monitoring number and an SOS or friends number, when you dial from your phone, it will activate a normal 2 way call, but when you press "call" in the app, it will only make a silent monitoring call.

SafeZone distance and Active day set up:

Click the “SafeZone Radius” and select the suitable SafeZone Radius of 2000 meters, 3000meters, 4000, meters or 5000 meters.

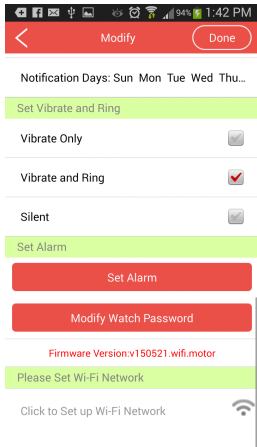

Then select which days of the week you want the SafeZone to be active, to receive a notification if the watch goes in/out of the SafeZone. This sets the radius for all SafeZones created for this watch only.

Set vibration and ring:



Press to tick the box or cancel the tick box, to activate or deactivate selected vibration mode on the watch. Press the “Save” button to save new settings.

Silent: Select the “Silent” tick box to place the watch into silent mode. This will stop the watch from ringing or vibrating for incoming calls, with the screen lighting up when a call comes in. Press the “Save” button to save new settings.

Set the alarm clock for the watch from the App and the alarm will be received by the watch at the appointed time.


Click to select the preferred WiFi network, and click “Edit” to name the WiFi network. No WiFi passwords are required. For example, if you are at home you can detect your home WiFi network and save it to the app for each watch. When that WiFi network is detected or lost you will get a notification letting you know that the watch has “Entered” or “Exited” a WiFi network. You can add as many WiFi locations as you want for each watch.

Safe list: Only the phone numbers you pre-set in the App are allowed to call the watch. The watch can also see these numbers in the contacts list and call them.

The App will allow more than 10 Sub-Guardians for the same watch, but other Sub-Guardians besides the 10 pre-set numbers cannot call or silent monitor the watch. However they will have all of the functionality of the App such as checking the location, seeing the Location history, setting SafeZones and receiving notifications on the App.





Once you log into the App, it will automatically open on your Watches list.

Click on any watch to see the location of that watch, to call the watch, to check the location history and to set your SafeZones.

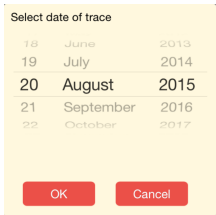
Positioning/Location: For normal use, the watch will operate under normal work mode, reporting the current location at 30 minute intervals. When you wish to see the current or Live watch location, the watch will operate under high-frequency positioning mode. High frequency will send the location every 60 seconds for the next 10 minutes.

Click the “Live” button and the App will display the current location of the watch and report the current location at a high frequency.

Click  or  on screen to check the location History.

Call: The “Call” button will activate a call to the watch.

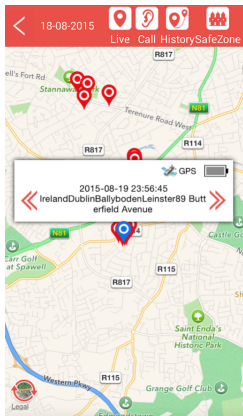

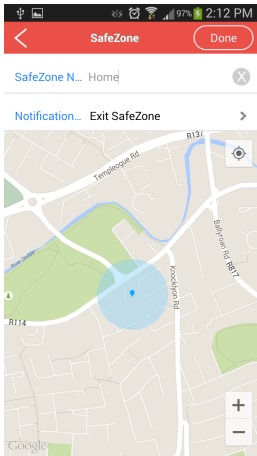

Press the “History” button and select the date by rolling up and down, click OK when the required date has been displayed. A map showing the



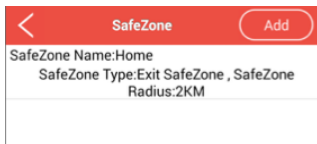
SafeZone: Set a SafeZone for the watch and when the watch exits or enters the SafeZone, depending on your chosen setting, you will receive a notification through the App.



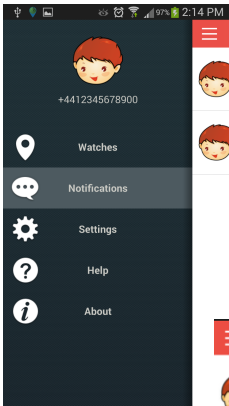
- Click “Add” and enter the “SafeZone Name”. Select “Notification Type”, move the watch location pin to where you want to set the centre of the SafeZone and pinch the map bigger or smaller to set the SafeZone area within the blue circle. The SafeZone will set to a radius of either 2,000m, 3,000m, 4,000m or 5,000m as per the Master Guardians settings in


the watch settings. Click “Done” to save the SafeZone.

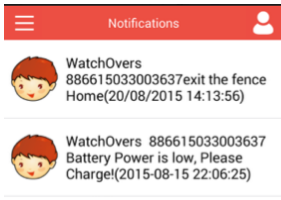
- Note, if you wish to set a SafeZone in a location not displayed on the screen, such as a long distance from the current location, pinch the map smaller until you see the area or country you require and then pinch the screen again to zoom in on the location you require.
- If you have set several SafeZones, the SafeZone list will be shown in SafeZones. Tap the SafeZone on screen once to modify. Press the SafeZone on screen for 3 seconds to delete the SafeZone.



Notifications



To view the notifications logs on your phone, click  on the App screen face or swipe right on the screen and click Notification, to view all notifications. When the watch enters or exits a SafeZone, receives a message or dials the SOS emergency numbers, your phone will receive the notifications on the App.

designated as the Master Guardian. All subsequent Guardians will require the Master Guardians' password to add the watch to their smartphone. The Master Guardian can create all the watch settings such as the SOS numbers, Friends numbers, Silent monitoring numbers, SafeZone radius and Calendar, Watch Password, Watch WiFi Network, Alarms etc.

If you wish to be the Master Guardian, add and confirm your password.

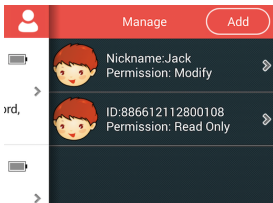

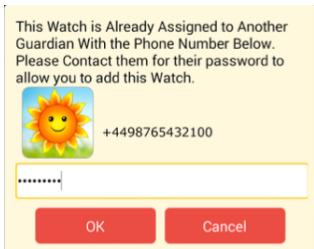

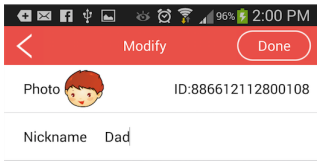


If you do not wish to be the Master Guardian, stop the set up and let another Guardian set up the watch first.

You can then add the device as a Sub-Guardian.

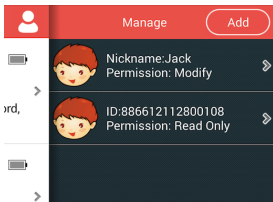


When you see this screen, contact the Master Guardian for their password and add in the password to become a Sub-Guardian.



When you become a Sub-Guardian, you cannot see the full set up page, only the photo, ID and the Nickname.

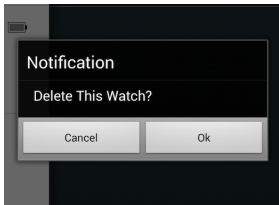
For “Jack’s” watch, you are the Master Guardian:



Modify: You are Master Guardian and have all settings rights.

Read Only: For the 2nd watch you are the Sub-Guardian. You cannot set SOS and other such settings.

Alternatively the Master Guardian can delete the watch from their smartphone which will allow you to become the new Master Guardian after you pair the watch again.



To delete the watch and release control, the Master Guardian can press the screen on the watch name for 3 seconds and press Ok.

Safety Warning

- Use only the original accessories recommended by the manufacturer. Using other accessories may be dangerous and invalidate all warranties and licences.
- Do not attempt to repair the watch yourself, as any modification to the product will affect the use of the product and affect the warranty.

Instructions for handling batteries (where necessary)

- Batteries should be disposed of responsibly. Battery must be fitted with the positive and negative placed correctly, if fitted incorrectly, it may cause damage to the watch. It is dangerous to try to open the battery or throw the battery into a fire. Never place the battery in the hands of children.
