


Timeline and Frequently Asked Questions



Example: Call Geddes on April 1st to enroll in and customize your fundraiser. The site will be active by April 8th. Flyers or Emails should be sent home with students on April 10th. The two week window for ordering on the website would be April 10th – April 24th. All orders placed will be consolidated by Geddes into bulk orders by April 24th. The bulk order will ship within 2 -3 weeks and arrive at the school by May 16th. Volunteers will be needed to separate into individual orders. Order may go home with students as soon as they are completed. Please Note: Any school using the Anytime Fundraiser as an end of the year fundraiser may delay shipment until school is back in session.

F.A.Q's

What if I do not have an account currently with Geddes? No problem! We will open an account for you. All payments are collected on the online website for the fundraiser and you receive your profit check at the conclusion of the fundraiser.

What if I want other Geddes products included in our fundraiser? We are unable to offer other items that are not currently part of the Anytime Fundraising program. If there are items you would like to suggest, we would love to hear them. You can always place a regular order on your account for those items on the web or by calling (888) 431-1722

Can I have my order shipped to an address other than the schools? Typically the shipment will go to the address of the organization sponsoring the fundraiser.

When is payment due? Payment is collected at the time orders are submitted on the website.


Can I pay with a credit card? We take American Express, MasterCard, Discover and Visa on the fundraising website

Can I pay with a PO? No, all money is collected on the fundraiser website

Can I apply any discount codes? The Anytime Fundraiser is not eligible for any coupon codes and discounts.

Does the Anytime Fundraiser count towards my Get More Rewards? No, the anytime fundraiser purchases do not qualify for the Get More Program.

When will I receive my items? Once your fundraiser is complete, it will take Geddes 2-3 weeks to customize your order. Once the order ships the delivery times will be as estimated below:



I run a Church Organization/Charity/After School Program/other non-school organization. Can we participate in the fundraiser? Of Course!! The Anytime Fundraiser can be used to raise funds for all types of programs.

How can I ensure a high participation rate from my student body? We suggest customizing the fundraiser page with the reason you are doing the fundraiser. Many people like to know how the funds are being spent and often like to rally behind a cause. We also suggest sending reminder emails and notes home with the students. In addition having competitions or raffles for prizes increases participation.

What if our parents/students aren't happy with the products they purchased? Will Geddes refund their money? Our business is built on keeping our customers happy! If you are ever less than completely satisfied with anything you order from us, we want to hear about it. Raymond Geddes products are unconditionally guaranteed. If you are dissatisfied with your order or the items within your order, you can return the item for a refund or replacement.

If our school already purchases products from you for our school store, can we still enroll in the fundraiser? Certainly!! This is a program that can benefit any school; those that currently have a school store and those that do not.

What if my school has low enrollment? Schools of any size can benefit from the Anytime Fundraiser. Below is an example of a school order and potential profit from the fundraiser. The Anytime Fundraiser does not have minimum order quantities or a minimum participation rate and includes free shipping on orders of \$150 or more. Your profit percentage does not decrease with lack of participation.

Scenario 1: 50 students participate, choosing an average of 5 items each. The school makes \$360 (most schools can hit this threshold, very little participation)

Scenario 2: 150 students participate, choosing an average of 10 items each. The school makes \$2,160 (moderate participation) Scenario 3: 500 students participate, choosing an average of 12 items each. The school makes \$8,640 (high level of participation)

Scenarios based on averages. Actual results may vary.
