Free Agent Roster

- A. Define as players who is registered to no Team
- B. Iszzy Sports oversees this team
- C. Free Agent Team will also play one game a week (min 5 Players)
- D. Free agents can be added to a team no later than the 3rd game

Uniforms

- A. All players must have the same color jerseys with numbers on the front and back
- B. Blue and black are NOT the same neither is yellow and white
- C. Uniform rules will be enforced by the 3rd game
- D. T-shirts/jerseys with tape or sharpies are not allowed
- E. Any uniform violations will result in 2 free throws per violation and the ball

• Time Management

- A. Teams have 5 minutes until clock starts. For every minute that pass the opposing team will receive 2 points
- B. If team does not show up by halftime, it's a forfeit. (See list of fines)
- C. 4 players to start the game
- D. 4 10-minute quarters with a 5 min halftime. Clock only stops the last 2 minutes of the second half if point differential is less than 10
- E. If a player is at the free throw line and the point difference is 10 the clock stops until the free throw is made.
- F. Overtime and double overtime are 3 minutes.
- G. If there is a third overtime first to score wins (Regular Season)
- H. Tournaments and championship games will have a 3-minute 3rd overtime
- I. Fourth overtime will only be played in championship game

• Time outs

- A. 4 full time-outs for the regulation game.
- B. Time outs will not carry over from regulation to OT
- C. 2 time-outs per half. Time outs in the 1st half do not carry over!
- D. 1 time-out will be given out in each OT quarter
- E. Injury time out is not a time out

Fouls

- A. One and One on the 7th team foul
- B. 2 shots on the 10th team foul
- C. Each player is allowed 5 personal fouls
- D. Team fouls do not carry over to the second half
- E. 2 free throws for every technical foul and the possession
- F. If a player accumulates 2 technical fouls, the player will be out of the game + 1 game suspension or fined (league admin will assess reinstatement)
- G. Referees have the authority to sit a player out to cool off. (Maximum 5 minutes)

Possession

- A. Team that does not win tip-off will have possession in 2nd half
- B. Team with possession is allowed to advance to half court after a time out only in the 2nd half.

Tournaments

- E. Team with least number of points in loser bracket is out of the running if there is an uneven number of teams.
