SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

1/1 RC: K2tog, leaving worked sts on the LHN. K the first st on the LHN then drop the worked sts off the LHN

1/1 LC: Re-orient the first 2 sts, if necessary. K the second st tbl, leaving the worked st on the LHN. Knit the first and second sts tog tbl then drop the worked stitches off the LHN.

K2TOG TBL KTBL: Re-orient the first st, if necessary. K2tog tbl, leaving worked sts on the LHN. K second st on the LHN tbl then drop the worked sts off the LHN.

KTBL K2TOG: Re-orient the first st, if necessary. K the first st tbl, leaving worked st on the LHN. K the first and second st on LHN tog then drop the worked sts off the LHN.

Chart A

Both sides the i-cord should be worked as follows:

Knit 3 sts and end the row work 3 SL PW WYIF.

Chart B

For the section worked with Chart B:

After working the chart once, continut the shawl by working i-cord on the edge stitches as before. Incorporate the increased stitches into the stitch pattern set by the repeat box.
