


## Mary Jane Mucklestone and Gudrun Johnston: Grand Shetland Adventure Knits

# Lotta H. Löthgren: Observations

Observations: Knits and Essays from the Forest is a knitted walk through the forest and the seasons. With a keen eye for the innate wonders of the natural world, Lotta H. Löthgren combines knitwear designs with notes of the landscape she calls home: a small village in the southeast of Sweden, nestled among forests and lakes. There, she spends her days writing, knitting, designing knitwear, hand-dyeing yarn and running her own yarn shop.

Observations includes nine knitwear patterns for longlasting, wearable garments and accessories, along with essays about living a life close to nature.






#### Paula Pereira: Textured Knits

Textured Knits is a thoughtfully curated collection of contemporary and timeless handknits. The book includes sweaters, cardigans, shawls, and a pair of socks. The 20 fascinating patterns feature a variety of inventive ways to combine different textures, such as cables, colorwork, and embroidery. The result is a versatile knitwear collection that features stunning yet delicate elements. In true Laine-style, the knits are photographed and presented beautifully creating a publication that promises to be a true classic.

Paula Pereira is a Brazilian knitwear designer. She is currently based in Luanda, Angola, where she lives with her husband. Paula is constantly inspired by the textures, colors, and motifs she sees around her, especially in architecture and art, which she then turns into stitches. Textured Knits is Paula's debut book.

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# Claudia Quintanilla: Making Memories

Making Memories: Timeless Knits for Children is a charming collection by Claudia Quintanilla. It includes 25 knits for children — from cardigans, sweaters and two cosy blankets to smaller pieces, like socks and mittens. The majority of patterns are graded from newborns to 10-year-olds and feature various yarns as well as knitting techniques. The classic knits combined with the dreamy photography and playful illustrations create a children's knitwear book unlike anything seen in this genre before.

Claudia Quintanilla is a yarn shop owner and knitwear designer based in Toronto, Canada. Originally from El Salvador, Claudia found the colder climate of Canada to be the perfect setting for knitting. This journey culminated in the founding of her Toronto-based brickand-mortar yarn shop, Eweknit & Craft.





#### Cinthia Vallet: Mouche & Friends

Mouche & Friends: Seamless Toys to Knit and Love is Cinthia Vallet's debut book that includes patterns for 12 knitted toy animals, plus their garments and accessories. Cinthia brings her characters to life with little stories, creating a charming combination of a knitting book and a children's storybook. Cinthia walks her readers through the techniques step-by-step with clear, illustrated tutorials, which makes knitting easy and enjoyable. She also shares her tips on working small circumferences, picking yarns and preparing a toolbox for toy-making.

Cinthia's toy-making process is unique and totally seamless, which ensures a flowing knitting experience. The animals are knitted with natural fibres and worked in the round, starting from the nose and knitting down to the feet — growing a toy rather than building it.


Laine: 52 Weeks of Socks, Vol. II

The collection celebrates solidarity and cooperation: to showcase the many talented people in the knitting community, Aimée has put together a collection of not only patterns from designers around the world, but yarns from a variety of producers and dyers.





Laine: 52 Weeks of Easy Knits



Dee Hardwicke is an artist, designer and knitter whose work is inspired by her passion for colour and by her love of the British landscape.






#### Jenna Kostet: Knitted Kalevala

What does knitted folk poetry look like? How can a sweater be both a garment and a story?

Knitted Kalevala includes 18 knitting patterns — sweaters, cardigans and accessories — inspired by Kalevala. Considered a national epic in Finland, Kalevala contains old poems full of Baltic-Finnic mythology, ancient symbols, mythical creatures and nature. These as well as other Finnish, Scandinavian and Baltic influences can be seen in the decorative colourwork patterns of the designs. They are also a wonderful alternative to the popular Icelandic sweaters.

**Jenna Kostet** is a knitwear designer and a writer, known for her historical novels and children's books. She has studied ethnology and folkloristics.

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


## Lindsey Fowler: Salt & Timber: Knits from the Northern Coast


# Meiju K-P: Contrasts: Textured Knitting

As a designer, Meiju likes to combine challenging techniques with a pleasant knitting experience. Meiju's debut book, Contrasts: Textured Knitting, contains 22 patterns in a soft, delicate and feminine style which are mostly knitted from the top down, making their size easy to adjust.

Meiju lives in Helsinki, Finland with her husband and three sons. Even as a teenager, she never knitted from patterns, preferring to create her own designs. Later, knitwear design became a passionate hobby and part-time work. She hopes to spark new ideas for beginners and more experienced knitters.


#### Molla Mills: Crochet Crush

Timeless fashion and modern practicality are the starting points for **Molla Mills'** *Crochet Crush*. The 23 crochet patterns include both home decor and accessories, making everyday aesthetics accessible to everyone. The designs have been inspired by the colours of flowers, the moods of past summers, as well as Brooklyn's neighbourhoods.

Crochet's compact and sturdy fabric is best suited for wear-intensive things such as carpets and bags. This book is a collection, so you can combine patterns and vary the colours to your liking.






Laine: 52 Weeks of Shawls

This book is a continuation of the incredibly popular 52 Weeks of Socks which was published in 2020.






# Anna Johanna: Strands of Joy

Anna Johanna is a knitwear designer from Muurame, Central Finland. She is known for her often-romantic knits with much love for details, textures and colours. Since 2020, this former statistician has been designing full-time. Strands of Joy is her debut book.





## Pia Alapeteri: Friends in Food

Friends in Food by Pia Alapeteri is a fillable book for everyone who sometimes eats together with family and friends. Gradually, a lovely database for dinners, birthday parties and everyday meals grows in between the covers, listing friends' diets and allergies, favourite foods and ingredients they cannot stand. No more guessing how many guests drink tea or which plant milk anyone's coffee needs — all of this with a twinkle in the eye. The book also consists of short and encouraging true stories of eating together, simple recipes, and tips that make it easier to gather around a common table.

Pia Alapeteri is a food influencer, storyteller and an entrepreneur from Helsinki, Finland. She writes medium dry stories about food, wine and a little bit about love, too.





Laine: 52 Weeks of Socks

52 Weeks of Socks is the first hardcover book of Laine Publishing. This publication contains 52 knitting patterns by 46 designers, and is a true encyclopedia of socks. The patterns are beautifully photographed and laid out on 256 pages in the style Laine is known and loved for.
