Right shoulder

BO remaining 5 (5, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts.

KATE by Libby Jonson

p. 104

Gauge missing.

Gauge

26 sts and 38 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) on US 2.5 (3 mm) needles, in stockinette stitch after blocking.

p. 106

Shape left neck edge

Part of the instruction lines are duplicated. Please see the correct section below.

Shape left neck edge

Next row (RS) (inc row): K2, M1R, k to end. (1 st inc)

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 5 [5, 5, 7, 7] (9, 3, 3, 3) times more.

24 [24, 24, 26, 26] (28, 22, 23, 25) sts.

Next row (RS) (inc row): K2, M1R, k1, sl1, k to end. (1 st inc)

Next row: P to end.

Next row (inc row): K2, M1R, k2tog, sl1, yo, k to end. (1 st inc)

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3 [3, 3, 2, 2] (1, 4, 4, 4) time(s) more.

29 [29, 29, 30, 30] (31, 28, 29, 31) sts.

Sizes 3XL, 4XL and 5XL only:

Next row (RS) (inc row): K2, M1R, k2tog, sl1, yo, k4, sl1, k to end. (1 st inc)

Next row: P to end.

Next row (inc row): K2, M1R, k2tog, sl1, yo, k3, k2tog, sl1, yo, k to end. (1 st inc)

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows - [-, -, -, -] (-, 1, 1, 1) more time.

[-, -, -, -] (-, 31, 32, 34) sts.

Buttonhole band

Buttonhole row (WS) *P to m, RM, yo, p2tog, rep from * to last 1 st; p1.

p. 112

Rnd 37: P1, 1/1 LPC twice, *1/1 RPC, p1* five times, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LPC six times, p1.

AITO (former Shibui) by Melody Hoffmann

p. 132
