ABBREVIATIONS

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SL2: Slip 2 stitches together, as if to knit applies only to Midsummer Rose pattern.

All other slipped stitches to be done purlwise, with yarn in back on RS and yarn in front on WS, unless otherwise stated.

Chart E: Row 5 should start with K3.

Chart F: Rows 1 & 3 should start with K3.

Chart H: Row 3: K3, yo, k7, yo, k (yo, k7, yo, ssk, k4, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, k) rep to last 10 sts, yo, k7, yo, k3.

Sizes should read as follows:

S (M, L, XL, 2XL)

A clarification for row 5 (no errors in the pattern):

Row 5 (RS): Kfb, SM, k1, M1L, k to 1 st before M, M1R, k1, SM, k1, M1L, p2, M1L, work across back in est [p3, k1tbl] pattern, building new sts into the pattern as increases are made, keeping in mind that you may not finish a full repeat as you near the end of the row (Note: twisted sts should form a straight vertical line down the back), to 3 sts before M...
