### **Dusk**

p. 28

Yardage

Should be for 6 sizes in the following amounts:

910 (991, 1131, 1318, 1419, 1547) m / 995 (1084, 1237, 1441, 1552, 1692) yds.

p. 30

Length of body

Should be:

Repeat Rows 1–2 until piece measures 31 (31, 32, 31, 32, 33) cm / 12.25 (12.25, 12.5, 12.25, 12.5, 13)“ from the underarm CO edge...

### **Dragonfly**

p. 46

Short row shaping

Should be:

Short row 2 (RS): Create DS, knit to 5 sts after second marker, turn.

### **Dawn**

p. 87

Number of sts to CO should be:

132 (138, 140, 144, 150) (152, 156, 156, 160) sts.

### **Badger**

p. 127

Casting on

Should be:

With *smaller* needles and MC...

You can use the chart in the book or a slight variation of it (as in the sample sweater) by working Chart rounds 22-25 as follows:

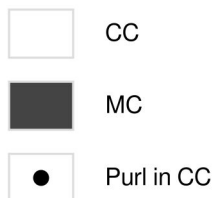
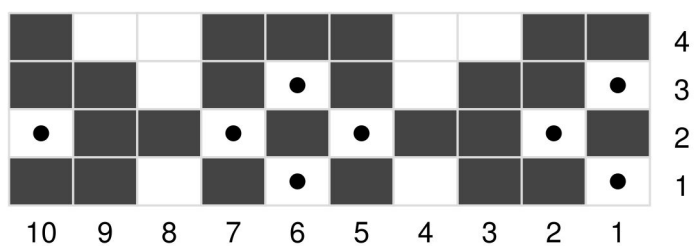
Round 22: 1Purl in CC, 2MC, 1CC, 1MC, 1Purl in CC, 1MC, 1CC, 2MC

Round 23: 1MC, 1Purl in CC, 2MC, 1Purl in CC, 1MC, 1Purl in CC, 2MC, 1Purl in CC

Round 24: 1Purl in CC, 2MC, 1CC, 1MC, 1Purl in CC, 1MC, 1CC, 2MC

Round 25: 2MC, 2CC, 3MC, 2CC, 1MC
