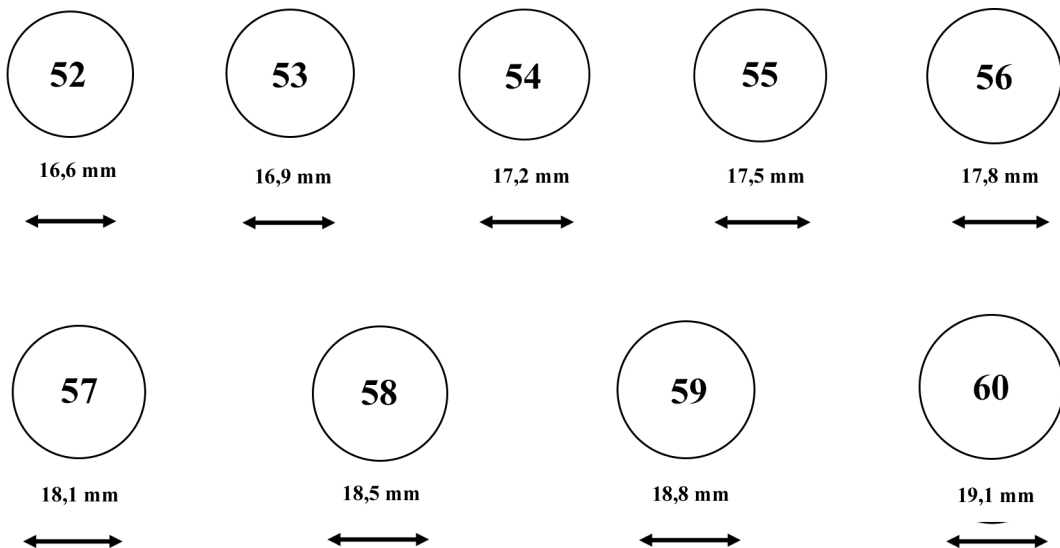

Rings sizes guide

1. Print this guide for ring sizes on A4 paper. NOTE - Be 100% sure that the printer does scale, shrink or enlarge the print.
2. Place the ring you want to measure over the circles on the paper. Find the circle that matches the ring - you must be able to see the outline of the circle on the paper inside your own ring.
3. Your ring is the size that is in the circle. The diameter is listed below in mm.



Be aware of the following when choosing a ring size.

- You measure most accurately when using a plain round ring that is not too wide.
- If you need a ring that is narrower than the one you are measuring, you may need a size down.
- If you need a ring that is wider than the one you are measuring - or want more rings sitting on the same finger, you typically need to go up a ring size.
- The ring sizes are only suggestions!
