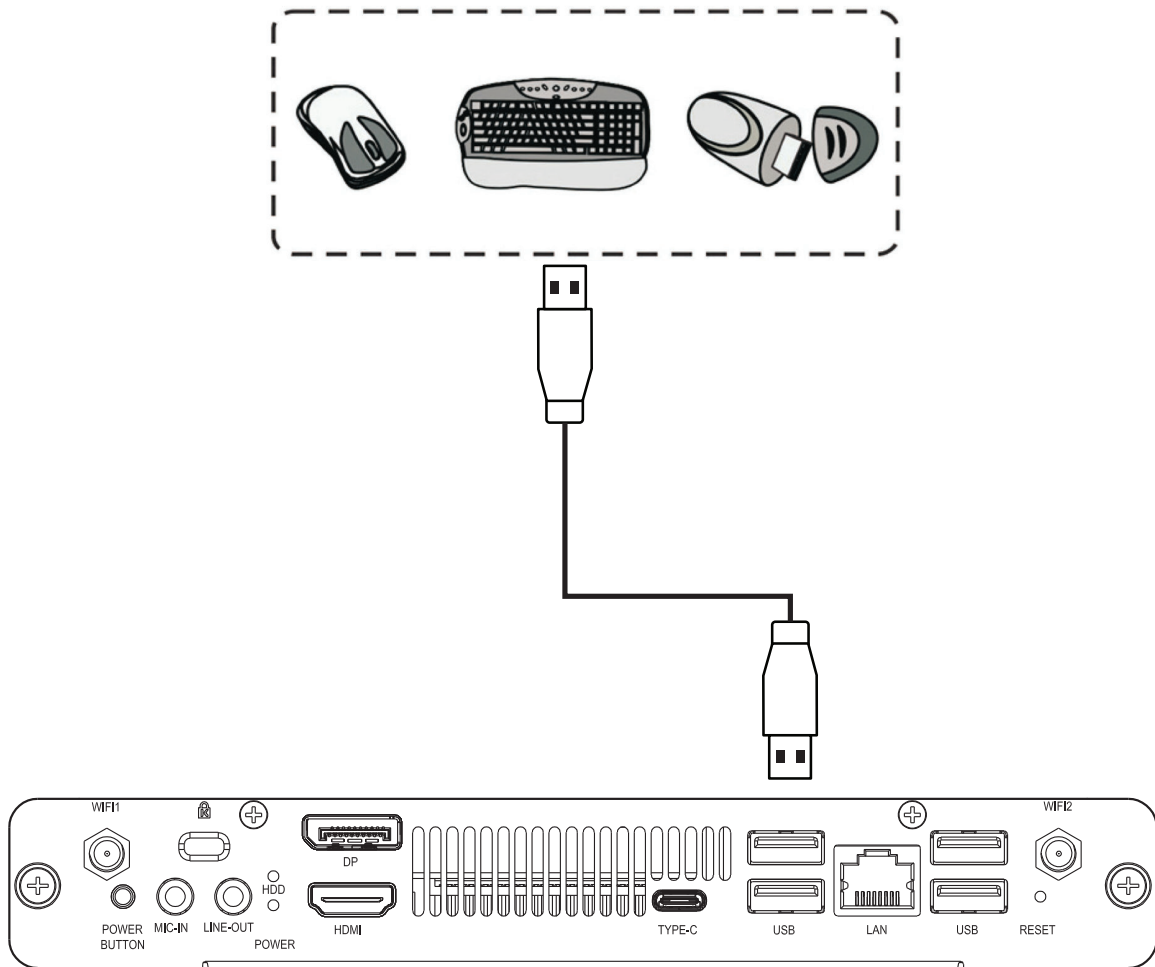
## 4. Input Selection
