

INSTRUCTIONS

WARM PEEL DTF

Prepress shirt for 5 seconds

HEAVY PRESSURE

310-330 F

10-20 seconds

Peel WARM

We found it was best to let sit for a few seconds before peeling. Use a cloth and rub the print with pressure before peeling.

It is recommended to press again for 5-10 seconds once film is peeled. Can be covered with parchment/butcher paper, teflon sheet, or no cover.

SCREEN PRINT

Prepress shirt for 5 seconds

SINGLE COLOR 325 F-350 F

PRESS 8-10 SECONDS

HEAVY PRESSURE

CLEAR FILM 325 F-350 F

PRESS 15-20 SECONDS

HEAVY PRESSURE!

Peel HOT



CUSTOM DTF

Prepress shirt for 5 seconds

325F for 15 seconds

HEAVY PRESSURE

Remove the garment from the press and let it stand until it is **COOL**, then peel film off.

Cover the image with parchment paper and press again for 15 seconds.

**Please note: If the image does not come off completely, repress with the image in place, let it cool, and repeat the film.*

Peel COLD

Iron on patch instructions on next page.

Do not wash or wear the garment for 24 hours after pressing* As with any product, the longevity of your design will be directly related to how you treat it. Wash inside out, cold, delicate cycle, and hang to dry. Top T is NOT responsible for pressing errors, application errors and washing errors.

IRON ON PATCHES:

COMMERCIAL HEAT PRESS

REQUIRED

Prepress shirt for 5 seconds

325-350F

HEAVY PRESSURE

Lay patch on garment and
cover with teflon or
parchment paper.

Press for 20 seconds.

Turn garment inside out and
press another 20 seconds.

SUBLIMATION:

Ready to press.

Colors will be brighter once pressed.
Sublimation ink shows best on high
polyester count fabric, does not work
on dark colors or cotton. We
recommend at least 50% polyester.
Must use heat press to apply (we
recommend 400 degrees F for 60
seconds).

All of our transfers are printed on
high quality sublimation paper and
high quality sublimation ink.
